Responding to the issue of vacany of SMS doctor in the area, the DDC directed the Chief Horticulture Officer to take the matter up with higher authorities for early filling of the post. He instructed to utilise the services of existing staff up to optimum level in the interest of fruit growers of the district. On shortage of teaching staff, the DDC constituted a Committee

The DDC directed the concerned to plan for the restart of Bhaderwah festival this year. Blacktopping of Jai-Gandoh road and early forest clearance of Kahara Jai Road was also stressed upon. The DDC also assured to take up the demand for opening of Army goodwill school with GoC for Army for which land was long ago acquired.

A deputation of youth demanded strict action against drug dealers/ peddlers. They also demanded for creation of sports infra-

structure in the Bhaderwah area to engage the youth in healthy activities. The DDC ensured that strict action under law would be taken against drug peddlers and necessary steps shall be taken to upgrade the sports infrastructure in the area.

On the non availability of a radiologist at SDH Bhaderwah, the DDC assured to take up the matter with concerned authorities. He suggested sending a local doctor to GMC Doda for short term training in radiology till the regular posting was made.

The ADC Bhaderwah was asked to monitor the attendance of doctors and ensure their presence from 10am to 4:30 pm for patient care.

On the issue of establishment of the Library at Bhaderwah, it was informed that a temporary library is functional at Old Hospital Bhaderwah, while land has been identified for construction of library building. The DDC asked the District Librarian to expedite the

process of documentation for early start of work on the building.

On the repair of the link road to the university campus, the PWD department informed that the proposal has been kept for the current financial year.

The DDC directed the labour department to organise Labour Camp at Bhaderwah on 1st Monday of every month in future.

## ADC inspects main water installations in Kishtwar Town

KISHTWAR: Acting on the public complaints regarding inequitable water supply distribution in the Kishtwar town and its adjoining areas, Additional Deputy Commissioner Kishtwar Kishori Lal Sharma inspected main water installations in the town and adjoining areas and took stock of the Water Supply Distribution System.

He was accompanied by Xen PHE Jal Shakti Division Kishtwar Anil Kailu, concerned Junior Engineers and field staff. During the inspection, a threadbare discussion was held with the XEN and JEs regarding the water distribution in the town and its periphery areas. The ADC Kishtwar found irrationalities and irregularities in the Water Distribution System (WDS). During the inspection, it was found that more than 20 service lines are in haphazard manner besides the feeding lines were irrationally laid. The ADC also found many bottlenecks neglected by the concerned departments which are impeding the proper and judicious distribution of water supply particularly in the town. He directed the XEN PHE to remove all such bottlenecks on an immediate basis to ease the suffering of the people. The department was strictly asked to maintain the water log book at every Installation i.e. Filtration plant, distribution junctions and consumer level. The field functionaries were directed to record the number of hours supply received and number of hours supply provided area wise/household wise for a transparent and judicious Water Supply Distribution System. The XEN PHE was asked to provide the list of all employees posted in Kishtwar town and its adjoining villages, their exact location of posting, area assigned, Pipe lines assigned, their previous three postings with stay position to District Administration to fix the responsibility and monitor the performance, including that of DRW, Casual Labourers and HR workers within three days.
