JAMMU: Justice B R Gavai, Judge, Supreme Court of India, on Saturday inaugurated AIR Café, e-Library and conference hall for Lawyers at Lawyers' Chambers Building, Court Complex, Jammu, Justice Dhiraj Singh Thakur, Justice Sanjeev Kumar, Justice Sindhu Sharma, Justice Rajnesh Oswal, Justice Sanjay Dhar, Justice Mohan Lal, Justice Rahul Bharti and Justice Moksha Khajuria Kazmi, Former Judges of High Court, D C Raina,

The twin facilities have been set up within

The e-Library available at AIR Café has been established with the help of All India Reporter Private Limited with the objective of augmenting the process of research and enrichment of knowledge.

In his inaugural address, Justice B R Gavai observed that the AIR Café will serve as a one stop research centre for the legal fraternity where they can enrich their legal knowledge with the assistance of legal publications and online e-

Library. He said that both the facilities will serve to enhance the legal capabilities and acumen of the lawyers and will foster the environment of sound learning. He described the bar and bench as the two golden wheels of the chariot of Justice and both must complement and supplement each other.

Sharing his personal anecdotes from his years at the bar, he suggested that the conference hall can be used judiciously as study centre for the purpose of advancement of legal learning and sharing of knowledge. On the occasion, Justice Dhiraj Singh Thakur described the visit of Justice B R Gavai as an encouragement for the members of the Bar. He advised the members of the fraternity to imbibe the qualities of humility and hard work.

Members of the Bar Association, Jammu and representative of All India Reporter Private Limited expressed their gratitude for setting up of the facilities which shall go a long way in contributing towards the cause of justice.

On the eve of Ramnavmi, a traditional Shoba Yatra(Shri Raghu Nath Ji Jhanki) is being taken out in Jammu city on 10.04.2022. The Shoba Yatra will start from Shri Raghu Nath Ji Temple and will pass through the following routes

ROUTE OF THE SHOBA YATRA

" Shri Ragnath Ji Temple -Residency Road-Rajinder Bazar-Kanak Mandi-City Chowk-Purani Mandi-Link Road-Jain Bazar- Chowk Chobutra-Panjthirithi-Mubarak Mandi -Pacca Danga-Moti Bazar-Raj Tilak Road -Old Hospital Road- Raghunath Bazar- and will culminate at Shri Raghu Nath Ji Temple"

A large number of devotees/prominent citizens are expected to accompany the Shoba Yatra and for hassle free passage of the Shoba Yatra, the below diversions shall be applied as per the ground requirement on spot by Traffic Police with the assistance of Local Police.

1.	Raghu Nath Temple	Traffic coming from Vivekananda Chowk or from Hari Market bound for Raghu Nath Bazar will be diverted to other routes at the time of procession
2.	City Chowk	Traffic from City Chowk bound to Kanak Mandi will be diverted to other routes till procession crosses City Chowk
3.	Parade	During the time of procession there will be some diversions for the vehicles bound for Panjthirithi /Parade upto J.P Chowk and vice versa

In view of route to be opted by organizers of Shoba Yatra, vehicular movement enroute shall be plugged and remain restricted to ease out the traffic pressure for smooth /hassle free movement of religious procession by the Traffic Police

The public in general and motorists in particular are advised to follow the traffic diversions/ restrictions as well as cooperate with the Traffic Police . Motorists shall avoid movement on the routes mentioned above during the Shoba Yatra and plan their travel accordingly through alternate routes to reach their destinations without any confusion. Inconvenience to General Public is regretted.
