SRINAGAR: Advisor to Lieutenant Governor, Rajeev Rai Bhatnagar on Thursday chaired the 157th Board of Directors (BoDs) meeting of JK Industries (JKI) at Civil Secretariat here.

He directed the officers to work in synergy and take some concrete measures to make the corporation more vibrant which would in turn contribute significantly towards revenue generation and employment. Fire Advisory

Do's:

- Harvest crop beneath high / low tension power line or around power transformer at first instance.
- Keep sufficient gaps in between crop heaps / stacks. A minimum of 20 feet distance be maintained.
- Panchayats / Village Committees should constitute farm fire vigil parties and night visit teams.
- Call fire and emergency services on phone "101" or inform police on phone no. "100", in case of any incidence of fire / sparking of transformers / short circuits with full details of location.
- Keep green branches available in the fields in order to beat fire.
- Be vigilant while using threshing machines in fields



Be Vigilant / Be watchfull

DO NOT's:

- Smoking near mature crops fields.
- Carry any burning or inflammable material in the fields.
- Operate any open cooking Chulah near stacks / heaps of crops, straw or dry grasses.
- Stacking under any high tension / low tension power lines.
- Prepare stacks / heaps > 6 mts. in height and weight of > than 2000 Kgs.
- Throw / break any glass items inside the crop fields as it may ignite fire.

Prevent Fires in Crops and contribute to Food Security
