JAMMU: Senior BJP leader Devender Singh Rana on Monday visited the Narsinh Temple, in the outskirts of the City of Temples, and expressed grave concern over the unfortunate, unholy and unpardonable act of desecration.

## DC Jammu discusses formulation of District Capex Plan 2022-23

JAMMU: Deputy Commissioner Jammu, Anshul Garg on Monday chaired a meeting to discuss the formulation of District Capex Plan 2022-23 and review the progress and achievements under last year's plan, here at DC Office Complex.

Chief Planning Officer, Yoginder Katoch and other

senior officers of the concerned departments were present in the meeting.

The officers of the concerned departments apprised the DDC about the expenditure made under district Capex 2021-22 and status of the projects.

The Deputy Commissioner asked the officers to formulate the plan in due consultation with PRIs, BDCs and

The administrative credibility is at all time low, given the deliverance and performance in various sectors of development. The power and water supply continues to be erratic while the roads are pock marked by ditches.

The accountability seems to be the last priority which is disgusting, he added.

Sadhotra asked the BJP to concentrate on governance rather than dividing the people and indulging in falsehood.

These are not going to take Jammu and Kashmir anywhere, he said and cautioned against testing the patience of the people, who feel pushed to the wall. Same is

true about the youth both educated unemployed as also skilled and unskilled work force due to growing unemployment. The pandemic times have added to the malady.



