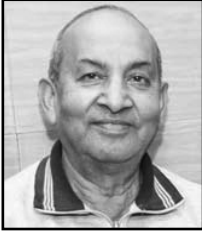

Weekly Block Diwas DC Srinagar holds Public Grievance Redressal camp at Shalteng

SRINAGAR: In order to bring Administration at the door steps of people for an on spot resolution of their developmental issues, the Deputy Commissioner (DC) Srinagar, Mohammad Aijaz Asad on Wednesday held a Public Grievance Redressal Camp at Benina in Shalteng Tehsil under weekly Block Diwas programme.

The programme was held within the premises of SDM/Tehsil Office Shalteng and witnessed large participation of people from Maloora, Mujngund, Ranbir Garh, Khushi Pora Panzinara-A, Panzinara-B, Zainakote, HMT, Tengpora Batamalo and other adjoining areas of Shalteng Tehsil of Srinagar.

During the Grievance Redressal Camp, PRI representatives, Public delegations and scores of individuals projected various issues and demands before the chair particularly the long pending issue arising out of jurisdictional overlap with Baramulla and Bandipora districts.

Besides, PRI representatives, individuals and other delegations, also demanded for maeadamization of roads, augmentation of water and power supply, repairs of

drainage system, upgradation of schools, providing electric poles, development of playground, commissioning of ITI Zainakote, development of Parimpora Fruit Mandi and General Bus Stand and other issues.

After giving patient hearing to the grievances and demands of the public, the DC sought on the spot response from the concerned District Officers present during the Grievance Redressal Camp.

He also assured the people of Shalteng Tehsil that all genuine demands and issues projected by them will be taken up with concerned authorities on priority. He said that the issue regarding jurisdictional issues has already been taken up with higher authorities and will be resolved soon.

The DC also gave on the spot directions to the concerned officers for time bound redressal of the public issues.

On the occasion, the DC asked the educated unemployed youth to come forward and take benefit from different Government self-employment schemes to earn a dignified livelihood for themselves and their family.

Later, the DC inspected several developmental works

including progress of work on construction of Industrial Training Institute (ITI), Zainakote being constructed at an estimated cost of Rs 4.88 crore.

On the occasion, the DC directed the concerned to expedite the work on construction of boundary wall around the premises of the Institute. He also asked the R&B authorities to prepare a DPR for construction of a Community Facilitation Center in the area so that people of the area are benefited.

The DC also directed the Tehsildar and other concerned to speed up the process of transfer of additional land to the Government Boys Higher Secondary School and Middle School to augment the upgraded facilities for both the schools.

Joint Director Planning, Mohammad Yaseen Lone, General Manager DIC, Hameeda Akhtar, Deputy Director Employment, Rouf-ul-Rehman, SDM West, Pimroze Bashir, Tehsildar, Shalteng, Younis Ahmad, besides other senior officers and Engineers of the District Administration were present in the Public Grievance Redressal Camp under weekly Block Diwas.

Pr Secy I&FC reviews progress of ongoing works at Hokersar wetland

SRINAGAR: Principal Secretary, Irrigation and Flood Control (I&FC), Ashok Kumar Parmar on Wednesday visited Hokersar wetland and took stock of ongoing works being carried out there for the restoration of the wetland.

The Principal Secretary was accompanied by Chief Engineer, I&FC, Kashmir, Naresh Kumar, S.E Hydraulic Circle, Budgam, Executive Engineer, Narbal, and other senior officers of the department.

During the visit, the

Principal Secretary highlighted that the wetlands are biological hot spots and play vital role in the conservation as well as ecological balance of nature. He remarked that Hokersar wetland needs to be developed as a tourist destination as it attracts beautiful migratory birds and Aves from Siberia and other cold places giving breathtaking sight to visitors.

Interacting with officers during the visit, the Principal Secretary sought information about the status of the proposed gates at the entry and exit of

Hokarsar wetland besides other technicalities of the works being carried out at the wetland.

The Chief Engineer, I&FC Kashmir informed the Principal Secretary that the department is going to construct two gates at the entry and exit of Hokarsar wetland. He added that the width of the gates is 80m each and the height is 3m each. The purpose of the gates is to ensure all season inundation of the Hokarsar so that the wetland provides a safe habitat to the migratory birds particularly during the winter season.

The Chief Engineer also apprised the Principal Secretary that the gates are automatically controlled with all the digital control system and having sufficient provision for energy backup. He added that the gates are being constructed by the I&FC department to comply with the NGT guidelines with respect to the wetlands.

Meanwhile, the Principal Secretary also visited the site of Flood Spill Channel at Shareef Abad bridge and reviewed the progress on restoring of Flood Spill Channel there.

DC B'pora chairs meeting for formulation of Capex Budget 2022-23

BANDIPORA: The Deputy Commissioner (DC) Bandipora, Dr Owais Ahmad on Wednesday chaired a meeting of officers to discuss the formulation of District Capex Plan 2022-23.

The meeting held threadbare discussion with regard to the formulation of District Capex Plan 2022-23 and the audience was informed about the methodology and priority areas. Officers informed about the way forward for District Development Plan formulation as per circular instructions of the Government under 3 tiers planning system and revealed

the Uniform templates devised for the purpose of propagation and consolidation through Gram Sabhas.

On the occasion, DC asked the officers to formulate the plan in due consultation with PRIs, BDCs and DDCs of the district and urged the PRI members to prioritize works as per needs and larger public interest. He said that key issues and critical infrastructure gaps will be incorporated at each level to push development in the district to the next level. He urged officers to focus on completion of halted/incomplete buildings and improvement in existing buildings,

Smart classrooms in the Education Sector and hospital upgradation, especially the completion of halted/ incomplete buildings in the Health Sector.

He also instructed them to focus on introducing Solar Lighting Systems, development/preservation of Ponds, development of Parks, development of Playfields and sports equipment besides laying a special focus on Waste Management in rural areas.

The DC said District and Sectoral officers concerned with the District Development Plan shall earmark sufficient allocation for completion of all ongoing

schemes in due consultation with all concerned PR institutions and representatives.

He directed officers to have on-spot visits in the field to see feasibility of each work besides proper estimation within given timelines. He also asked officers to formulate a comprehensive schedule and Calendar for all 151 panchayats, phase wise where besides organizing Gram Sabhas all concerned and representatives of departments who are scheduled to be present along with other PRIs representatives in order to facilitate the preparation of action plan for the concerned panchayat Halqas.
