JAMMU: To create awareness among people about scientific waste management and mitigate River water pollution due to waste littering during puja ceremonies / rituals, a "Save Tawi Campaign" was organised by J&K Pollution Control Committee, Jammu on Wednesday. The event coincided with "Holy Sakth Visarjan" which was held in collaboration with DISHA organization, Live For Others-Being helpful foundation & Climate Front Jammu. Around 150 students from GGM Science College, GCW Parade, MAM College, commerce college, Jammu University (Department of Environmental Sciences & Sociology), staff of J&K Pollution Control Committee, Jammu Municipal Corporation and Rural & Urban Development Agency (RUDA) participated. Awareness cum waste collection camps were setup at two main Visarjan Ghats, viz., Har ki Paudi and Birkram Chowk by the J&K Pollution Control committee in order to reach out to the devotees at the spot of Sakth Visarjan, to interact with them and sensitize them to not immerse any other puja material apart from holy Sakth to prevent pollution of Holy River.

During the "Save Tawi Campaign", segregated waste collection was done directly from devotees, followed by secondary segregation of waste with help of workers engaged by Jammu Municipal Corporation and all segregated waste including plastic was collected by Rural and Urban Development Agency (RUDA) for further recycling and scientific disposal. Mata Chunri shall be sent to NGO Gooj, based in Delhi for making dresses for needy children. Cocomuts were distributed as Prasad among devotees and local people. Flower waste was collected by JMC for further composting at Bandu Rakh. Clay pots used for growing Sakth shall be used by people for feeding water to birds, food to stray animals etc.

Neelu Gera, Chairperson, JKPCC appreciated the initiative taken by JKPCC, Jammu to raise awareness among people and stressed upon the need to prevent littering and dumping of non-biodegradable items including plastics and polybags etc. She further emphasized that community involvement has proven to be the most effective tool in making such initiatives successful.

The campaign was conducted by the JK Pollution Control Committee under the supervision of K. Ramesh Kumar, Member Secretary, JKPCC, Sh. Sat Paul, Regional Director, JKPCC, Jammu, Divisional Officers, JKPCC Jammu (North & South) and Anuradha, Scientist, JKPCC.

Following is notified for the information of the General Public in terms of various provisions of J&K Unified Building Bye Laws 2021, so far as these pertain to issuance of Building Permissions by Jammu Development Authority in its jurisdiction.

(i) **Bye Law 1.2(8) Authority having jurisdiction** :- Vice Chairman, JDA shall be the Authority for administering the Bye-Laws.

(ii) **Bye Law 1.2(11) Building Permit Issuing Authority (BP1A)** :- Vice Chairman, JDA shall be the BP1A.

(iii) **Bye Law 1.2 (34) Designated persons** :- Following shall be the designated persons for receipt of documentation and clearances on behalf of Development Authority through OBPS.

(i) **Bye Law 2.1 Jurisdiction of Building Bye Laws** :- These building Bye Laws shall apply to Building activity in the entire area of jurisdiction of Jammu Development Authority.

(ii) **Bye Law 2.10(c) Fee for permission**:- Fee for Building permission shall be Rs. 3 per Sq.ft of built up area for residential irrespective of whether it is for individual house or group housing Building fee. For carving housing Colonies the building permission fee shall be Rs 4000/- per kanal. The fee in respect of other uses shall be Rs. 25 per sq.ft of the built up area.

(iii) **Bye Law 2.14.2 (b) (iii) Process and Penalties for failure to discharge responsibilities as Registered Technical Person (RTP)**:-

- Process**:- Site inspection by CTP, JDA viz-aviz approved drawing and checking of drawings construction under the building norms (Bye laws)
- Penalties**:- Penalty for failing to discharge responsibilities shall be as under:-
- On failure in discharging the responsibilities first time; the RTP shall be suspended for six months with a penalty of Rs. 5000/-.
- On failure in discharging the responsibilities second time; the RTP shall be suspended for one year with a penalty of Rs. 10000/-.
- On failure in discharging the responsibilities third time; the RTP shall be suspended perpetually and his case recommended to other ULB and UDA for blacklisting.

(iv) **Bye Law 2.14.2 (C) (v) Appellate Authority**:- The Appellate authority shall be Chairman, Jammu Development Authority Jammu.

(v) **Bye Law 2.19 (b) Listing Fees and Security Deposit**:- Listing fee for Persons on Record with BP1A shall be one-time Rs. 10000 and one time Security Deposit of Rs. 10000/-.

(vi) **Bye Law 2.14.2 Notice for Commencement of Construction**:- The format for Notice for Commencement of Construction shall be as per Annexure 'A'-9(i).

(vii) **Bye Law 4.1.9 Authority to be Notified of Progress of Construction**:- The format of the Notice shall be as per Annexure 'A'-9(ii).

(viii) **Bye Law 4.1.10 Permit to Proceed with Construction Required**:- The format for Permit to Proceed with Construction shall be as per Annexure 'A'-9(iii).

(ix) **Bye Law 5.3.2 Note v Permissible & Non-Permissible Uses as per use Zones as per the existing road width**

The Mixed-Use Zone as per table 5-2 shall be allowed along Govt. Notified roads up to a depth of 2.5 times of the RoW of the approach road.
