

DG BRO calls on LG Mathur

Provides update on various ongoing projects



DG BRO Lt General Rajeev Chaudhary calling on Lt Governor of Ladakh, RK Mathur.

LEH: Director General (DG), Border Roads Organisation (BRO), Lieutenant General Rajeev Chaudhary called on the Lieutenant Governor of Ladakh, RK Mathur, at Raj Niwas on Thursday.

DG BRO Lt Gen Rajeev updated LG Mathur on their ongoing project works in Ladakh, including the Hanuthang-Handanbroke-Zingpal-Turtuk road, the status of the detailed project report (DPR) for Kela Pass, the construction of Chushul-Demchok road and progress on the Nimoo-Padum-Darcha road.

Lt Gen Rajeev also informed about setting up new RCC Units and Task Forces and the need for allotment of land for carrying out various project works in Ladakh. He also apprised about using the latest technology and equipment to expedite the completion of various projects in Ladakh.

LG Mathur appreciated BRO for opening the Zoji-La and Manali-Leh National Highways in record time and also for working for the welfare of the labourers. He inquired about the timeframe and challenges faced by BRO in the completion of the Nimoo-Padum-Darcha road.

and also suggested that BRO may simultaneously develop an alternate route. He also requested BRO for improvement of the gradient of the Nimoo-Padum-Darcha Road.

Lt Gen Rajeev also provided updates on the installation of crash barriers using steel wire ropes on roadsides to avoid accidents and setting up labour sarai with proper heating, washing, drinking and bathing facilities for labourers. He further informed that BRO is providing labourers with sleeping bags and goggles, and snow tents with heating facilities for labourers working in remote and high-altitude areas.

He also informed about their initiative for the establishment of cafes along the national highway in Ladakh.

DG takes stock of damage to orchards by hailstorm in Baramulla

SRINAGAR: The Director Horticulture Kashmir, Ajaz Bhat on Thursday visited various areas of district Baramulla including Sherpora, Mamooza, Kanloo, Babagund, Sari, Nehalpora, Lalpora Kunzer, Lalpora Tangmarg, Dobwan, Pinjora etc which witnessed hailstorm yesterday causing damage to fruit crops.

He was accompanied by Chief Horticulture Officer Baramulla and other field functionaries of the Department.

Pertinent to mention that yesterday evening hailstorm occurred in various parts of the valley, however its severity was not much in other districts. On the occasion, DG expressed his sympathies with the affected fruit growers.

Referring to the extent of the damage, he said that about 20-25% damage has occurred

in these areas. He advised the orchardists not to panic as it is still in recoverable stage.

He further said that special teams have been framed in the affected districts to assess the damage.

Meanwhile, orchardists of the affected areas were advised to follow recommendations like the orchards be immediately sprayed with any one of the these fungicides (per 100 lit. of water)

Zineb 68% + Hexaconazole 4% 72 WP (100 g) or Metiram 55% + Pyraclostrobin 5% 60 WG (100 g) or Manezob 75 WP (300g) or Zineb 75 WP (300 g) or Zineb 75 WP (300 g).

In addition to these, the orchards may be sprayed with Urea @ 0.2% (200 g per 100 lit. of water).

Besides, maintain proper orchard sanitation and remove fallen fruit & leaves from the orchard.

- Use mosquito repellents (creams/liquid sprays/mats/coils)


PREVENT ENTRY OF MOSQUITOES
