604 vaccinated, 1,763 samples collected in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing with enforcement drive for strict adherence to Covid protocols on Saturday fined scores of violators for not wearing face masks and not maintaining social distance in the district. The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 5600 from violators while urging the public to follow covid appropriate behaviour besides taking Covid vaccine at their nearest vaccination cen-

tre.

As per a report issued by the District Immunization Officer Dr. Suresh, the Health Department administered covid vaccine to 604 persons, including 504 children from 15-17 years-age group in the district. According to bulletin by Chief Medical Officer Dr. Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 1763 samples including 493 RT-PCR and 1270 RAT samples besides administering Covid vaccine to 604 persons at various dedicated vaccination centres in the district.
