## Rename Kathua-North as Jasrota Assembly segment: Balbir

NEW DELHI: Former Member of the Legislative Council (MLC) and senior Congress leader Thakur Balbir Singh demanded that the proposed Kathua-North Assembly Constituency should be renamed as Jasrota Assembly Constituency to fulfill the demand of the locals.

As prominent persons of the proposed Kathua-North Assembly Segment have approached Thakur Balbir Singh to get the name of the proposed Assembly constituency should be renamed as Jasrota, former MLC during his visit to New Delhi brought this matter to the notice of the Delimitation Commission.

In a statement, Thakur Balbir Singh said that the demand was raised before the members of the Delimitation Commission who assured to seriously consider this demand, keeping in view the sentiments of the local people.

"During my recent visit to New Delhi, this demand was raised before the Delimitation Commission. We are hopeful that this demand will be accepted by the Commission", Singh said and pointed out that like Mata Vaishno Devi and Bahu assembly segments, Kathua-North should be renamed as Jasrota Assembly segment.

He said that renaming Kathua-North as Jasrota Assembly segment is the demand of all section of the society of this newly carved assembly constituency.

"Sentiments of the people are attached with this demand because Jasrota has historical importance. Jasrota was once the capital city", Singh pointed out and observed that declaring Kathua-North as Jasrota Assembly Constituency will address the emotions and sentiments of the people.

Thakur Balbir Singh further demanded that statehood should be restored to fulfill the aspirations of the people. He reminded that Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Union Home Minister Amit Shah have repeated assured to restore statehood to J&K.

"It is high time to restore statehood because this step will revive the confidence of the people of J&K before assembly elections", Singh said.

## 604 vaccinated, 1,763 samples collected in Ramban

RAMBAN: Continuing with enforcement drive for strict adherence to Covid protocols across the district, the Enforcement teams on Saturday fined scores of violators for not wearing face masks and not maintaining social distance in the district. The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 5600 from violators while urging the public to follow covid appropriate behaviour besides taking Covid vaccine at their nearest vaccination centre.

As per a report issued by the District Immunization Officer Dr Suresh, the Health Department administered covid vaccine to 604 persons, including 504 children from 15-17 years-age group in the district. According to bulletin by Chief Medical Officer; Dr Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 1763 samples including 493 RT-PCR and 1270 RAT samples besides administering Covid vaccine to 604 persons at various dedicated vaccination centres in the district.
