tweet, the CISF said its personnel were attacked by terrorists while going for an ongoing cordon and search operation.

"Had they succeeded and were not forced to take shelter in a nearby residential area, the casualty among the forces could have been much more," CISF Deputy Inspector General (DIG) for operations and chief spokesperson Anil Pandey told PTI.

The two terrorists were killed in the ensuing encounter with the security forces.

Another officer said a team of 15 Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) personnel onboard a static private bus was just about to take charge from those who were finishing their night duty when the attack took place around 4:25 am.

The bus driver ran away after the terrorists launched heavy gunfire and lobbed grenades even as the security personnel quickly took position and retaliated, he said.

A cordon-and-search operation is being carried out in the area for the last two-three days and the CISF team was part of it on Friday.

According to the police, the gunfight began when the terrorists opened fire on the search party.

The officials said nine security personnel, including two policemen, were injured in the gunfight. A CISF personnel and a police personnel sustained grievous injuries.

As the CISF troops retaliated, the terrorists fled and entered the house of Mohammad Anwar, they said.

The security forces zeroed in on the house and killed one of the terrorists while he was moving towards the bathroom, where his associate had taken shelter, they said.

Efforts to neutralise the second terrorist took longer. He was killed in heavy gunfire and grenade hits, they said, adding the entire gunfight lasted a little over five hours.

On the identity of the slain terrorists, DGP Singh said an investigation is on but prima facie, it looks that the two were Pakistani nationals and had freshly infiltrated into this side from Pakistan. They have no history of terror activities in Jammu and Kashmir, he said.

The DGP said three weapons along with a lot of grenades were recovered from the possession of the slain terrorists.

They fired rifle grenades and some more security personnel were also injured after the initial casualties, he said, ruling out the presence of a third terrorist.

Responding to a question about local support to the terrorists, Singh said, "We have certain leads and we are working on them."

Two AK-47 rifles, an Under Barrel Grenade Launcher and a satellite phone were recovered from the slain terrorists, the police said.

Mobile internet services were suspended and schools in the vicinity of the encounter site were closed for the day as a precautionary measure.

On February 10 in 2018, three JeM terrorists stormed the Sunjwan Army camp and in the subsequent gunfight, seven people, including six soldiers, were killed. All the three terrorists were also gunned down.

This will be Modi's first visit to Jammu and Kashmir other than borders since the abrogation of the special status of the erstwhile state and its bifurcation in August 2019.

each other, the Union home minister added. Data is a new science, and big data has solutions to all the problems, Shah said, adding that police forces across the country must keep this in mind. Under the Modi government, security agencies have gained the upper hand via a vis terror groups, he claimed. The law and order is a state subject and that is why police work on the direction of elected governments in respective states. But in such a situation, forming uniform response becomes a major challenge, he said. If the state police continue to function in isolation, then it will not be possible to face all these challenges in a perfect manner, he said. India is emerging as a major power in the world as it has "democracy, demographic dividend, demand and decisiveness" and also a "leader capable of changing the country's destiny," Shah said. The prime minister has announced a technology mission for police in the country and the home ministry has drawn up a roadmap for this, he said. We will send it through BPR&D to the state police for seeking their suggestions and through it the entire police force in the country will be equipped with same type of equipment and technology, Shah said. About four lakh police personnel were affected by the coronavirus pandemic and 2,712 of them lost their lives in the line of duty, the Union minister noted, condoling their deaths. Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan also spoke on the occasion. The main objective of the conference is to provide a common platform to representatives of various police forces, social scientists, forensic experts and other stakeholders to deliberate on issues concerning police, an official said. About 100 participants from different states, union territories, Central Armed Police Force (CAPF), Central Police Organisation (CPO), prisons and correctional administration as well as forensic science laboratories and various universities are taking part in the conference, he added. Madhya Pradesh Governor Mangubhai Patel will chair the valedictory session on Saturday. After the event, Shah took part in a brief roadshow on his way to the state BJP headquarters.

in Samba and adjoining areas as a part of foolproof security," a senior official told PTI. The venue of the public function has been made out of bounds for the general public and a three-tier security arrangement has been made after conducting a full-fledged anti-sabotage checking, officials said. The administration has been making arrangements for the participation of one lakh people in the programme. The officials said checkpoints have been raised on all the roads lead-

ing to the venue, and vehicles and people using highways and peripheral roads in the area are being thoroughly checked and frisked. They said they have made elaborate deployments and carried out area-domination in view of the visit. Alertness in border areas has been raised and vigilance on vital installations in the region enhanced by various security agencies, they said. Security establishment carried out several drills on Friday including landing of choppers and movement of vehicles, they said. Sources said there are inputs about a greater threat perception this time. Intercepts have also been received about possible threats, they said, adding one group terrorist was neutralised Friday. Some high-end surveillance equipment have been inducted into security setup to ensure fool proof security, they said. In Jammu and Kathua, security has been beefed up with frisking and checking of vehicles increased, they said. This will be Modi's first visit to Jammu and Kashmir other than his trip to borders post since the abrogation of the special status of J&K in August 2019. Modi is expected to launch industrial investments worth Rs 70,000 crore and inaugurate and lay foundation of some developmental projects including two power projects.
