NIA takes over...

of Police (SSP)-rank officer, the officials said. They said the NIA took over the case amid disclosure by one of the arrested accused that he had earlier also ferried some more terrorists to Kashmir after their successful infiltration from Pakistan along the IB in Jammu.

On Monday, the arrested accused were remanded in police custody for 10 days after they were produced before the third additional sessions judge, also a designated NIA court. Police have also detained the house owner, where the terrorists had spent a day, for questioning. He has not been formally arrested though. The truck which was used in the transportation of the terrorists had also been seized, the officials said.

Announcing a breakthrough in the case on April 23, Additional Director General of Police, Jammu, Mukesh Singh they arrested Sheikh and identified the other accused on the basis of technical analysis.

"After the encounter, police teams worked tirelessly day and night to establish the identity of the conspirators who were behind this plan to carry out a suicide attack in Jammu which was successfully foiled," he had said.

On the basis of technical analysis and evidence, the police first zeroed in on Sheikh, who works at a walnut factory at Narwal which is not far away from the scene of the encounter. "Sheikh and his brother Asif are deeply involved with terrorists of JeM. Asif created a telegram ID called 'Pagal Jamaat' (mad group) for Shafiq and also provided him with a mobile phone with a SIM card. He also contacted a JeM commander in Pakistan by the name of 'Veer', his telegram identity," the ADGP had said.

He had said Wagay set out on the instructions of Pakistan-based JeM commander from Kashmir's Pulwama at 10 am on April 20 and reached Jammu around evening time. "He stayed at Transport Nagar and at around 12 am (midnight), he set out for Sapwal (border) in Samba and picked up two terrorists of JeM. They boarded a medium sized truck loaded with empty vegetable crates and neatly created a cavity among the crates for hiding the terrorists," the ADGP had said. They reached Jallabad locality of Smjwan around 2.30 am. Sheikh received the terrorists and took them to his house where they stayed during the day and discussed their plans with their handlers across the border.

security force personnel lost their lives to militancy in Jammu and Kashmir between the 1990s, when militancy first reared its head in the valley, and 2020.

Militancy in Jammu and Kashmir is intricately linked with infiltration of terrorists from across the border, the report said.

Besides Kashmiri Pandits, militancy forced some Sikh and Muslim families too to migrate from Kashmir Valley to Jammu, Delhi, and other parts of the country, it said.

Nearly 1,054 families from the hilly areas of Jammu migrated to Jammu plains, it said. As per the records of registration available with the Relief and Migrant Commissioner, J&K, at present 43,618 registered Kashmiri migrant families are settled in Jammu, 19,338 families are settled in Delhi and NCR, and 1,995 families in a few other states and the UTs in the country, the report said.

With a view to resettle Kashmiri migrants in the valley, the MHA has approved 3,000 jobs in the J&K government under Prime Minister's Reconstruction Package - 2008, and an additional 3,000 jobs under the Prime Minister's Development Package - 2015 (PMDP-2015). To house these 6,000 Kashmiri migrant employees in the valley, construction of 6,000 transit accommodations at an outlay of Rs 920 crore has also been approved by the MHA. Under the scheme, 1,025 flats have been completed or substantially completed and 1,488 are under construction.

The report said that a total of 2,546 terror incidents sponsored by Pakistan took place in Jammu and Kashmir from 2014 to 2020, in which 481 security personnel, 215 civilians, and 1,216 terrorists were killed.

There were 1,776 infiltration attempts from across the border to Jammu and Kashmir between 2014 and 2020, of which 685 were successful.

Consumers are requested to bear with the Corporation to tackle the situation by way of judicious use of electricity especially in peak hours so that system overload constraints are avoided.

The protesters briefly blocked the roads demanding restoration of water supply and an end to unscheduled power cuts.

We have raised the issue of acute water shortage with the concerned department time and again but no action is being taken which is very unfortunate, a resident of Waliabad locality of Sidhra said. Jammu Mayor Chander Mohan Gupta said the first priority of the corporation is to ensure uninterrupted power and water supply to the consumers.

We are aware of the problems and are making steps As far as the water crisis are concerned, the Jammu Municipal Corporation (JMC) will work with the Public Health Engineering department to ensure water supply to every household in the city, he said.

There are shortcomings which are being taken care of. Lakhs of gallons of water is leaked and wasted, while the water lifting pumps have not been upgraded for the past two decades, he said, adding the corporation will work overtime to fulfill the dream of har ghar nal ka jal' as envisioned by the prime minister.

Even as the power development department is out of the ambit of the corporation, Gupta said he will not hesitate to reach out to the union ministry of power to request for additional supply to overcome the present crisis. We will take up the issue with the Lt Governor and the concerned department as the power supply is required to lift water and provide it to the consumers, he said.
