

# Sanjeev Verma inaugurates DFO's conference

JAMMU: The Forest department on Tuesday organized one day DFO's conference to deliberate on deliverables assigned by the government for 2022-23.

Inaugurating conference, Commissioner Secretary, Forest, Ecology and Environment, Sanjeev Verma, congratulated the forest and sister departments for planting 137.20 lakh saplings during the last financial year besides plantation of over 95 lakh saplings through low cost interventions like seed balls, patch sowing and grass slips. He highlighted deliverables on restoration of water bodies especially the village ponds, Har Gaon Hariyali through 'One Beat Guard, One Village Program' under 'Green Jammu & Kashmir Drive'.

He directed the officers for creation of Nagar Vans, slope stabilization, promotion of ecotourism, catchment area treatment, engaging tourists in planting for branding, augmenting efforts on Forests for

Livelihood' and working closely with Rural and Urban Local Bodies. He also called for more afforestation outside forest areas for increasing carbon sequestration.

Speaking on the conference, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Head of Forest Force, Dr Mohit Gera, complimented the officers for initiating several innovative works like 'One Beat Guard, One Village Program', low-cost planting interventions, slope stabilization with modern methods of coir logs and geotextile mats, opening of 75 forest trek routes and city forests at several locations. He also complimented them for internalizing the participatory

planting with Gram Panchayats, Biodiversity Management Committees and Joint Forest Management Committees.

He asked the officers for promotion of medicinal and non-timber plants under CAMPA, restoration of degraded forest under Green India Mission and regular planting under CAPEX.

He informed that a total of 20,000 ha area will be brought under afforestation by the department.

The other targets to be achieved included survey and erection of 28,000 boundary pillars to secure forest land, coverage of 1500 villages under One Beat Guard, One

Village Program and coverage of all village panchayats under Har Gaon Hariyali campaign.

Sarvesh Rai, CEO CAMPA, Vasu Yadav, Managing Director, Forest Development Corporation, Brij Mohan Sharma, APCCF Jammu, T. Rabi Kumar, APCCF Kashmir, Dr. B. Balaji, CCF Planning and Projects spoke about various aspects of CAMPA, CAPEX, GIM, convergence with MGNREGA and wood based industries.

The conference further deliberated on the scope of augmentation of fodder, non-timber Forest produce, ecotourism for supporting livelihood of local communities through forest-based industry.

The participating officers shared their experiences about last year's activities besides discussing new activities to be undertaken this year.

Dr Gera outlined the deliverables assigned to the forest department for the current year besides highlighting the ways and means to deliver them effectively with involvement of stakeholders especially PRIs, line departments, educational Institutions especially the eco-clubs.

## CS reviews power, water scenario in J&K

SRINAGAR: Chief Secretary, Dr. Arun Kumar Mehta, on Tuesday chaired a meeting of Power Development and Jal Shakti departments at Civil Secretariat here to review power and water scenario in Jammu and Kashmir.

The meeting was attended by Commissioner Secretary Jal Shakti, M Raju, SMC Commissioner, Athar Aamir Khan, MD KPDC, Dr Basharat Qayoom, Secretary (Technical) PDD, Bashir Ahmad Dar, Chief Engineer, PHE Kashmir, Basharat J Kawoosa, Chief Engineer PDD (Transmission) Hashmat Qazi, Chief Engineer Projects PDD, Lateef Ahmad and Director Finance, Jal Shakti, Lateef Ahmad Poswal. Principal Secretary, Power Development Department, Niteshwar Kumar, Commissioner JMC, MD JKPTCL, MD JPDCL, MD JKSPDC, Chief Engineers of various wings of JPDC, Chief Engineer PHE and other senior officers attended the meeting from Jammu through video conferencing. Chief Secretary was briefed about the power scenario in the UT and the reasons

for the short fall in power sector. It was informed in the meeting that to mitigate short-fall in Jammu and Kashmir the Centre has allocated additional power to Jammu and Kashmir to meet the demand.

Chief Secretary directed the PDD to take immediate measures to provide adequate power supply during Iftaar' and sehri timings. He also directed them to reach out to the people and explain the reasons for the short fall in power supply. He said that people will understand if they are given factual position saying that consumers should be informed of the facts through print and electronic media. Chief Secretary directed the PDD officers to issue statements explaining the reasons of outages and the actions taken by the department and the same should be shared with social media and Information Department. He further asked the Power Development Department (PDD) to expedite installation of meters in rural areas. He said that the meters, spared from areas where smart metering is completed, should be installed in rural areas without any delay. He directed the officers to submit action taken

report within a week on the installation of 16000 meters that have been spared due to installation of smart meters.

He further directed the PDD and Jal Shakti departments to work in a coordinated manner so that water supply does not get affected due to outages as Jal Shakti schemes are power dependent. He said that dedicated feeders to PHE should be maintained well so that essential services so not suffer.

He directed the officers to maintain adequate water supply to the people and take prompt action on the issues faced by the public.

This for the information of general public that following Inclusion and Exclusion criteria has been notified by the Government vide S.O. 389, dated 16/11/2021 for identification and inclusion/exclusion of beneficiaries under National Food Security Act (NFSA):

#### a) Criteria for Inclusion

##### I. For Urban Areas:

- All Antyodaya Anna Yojana families;
- Households without shelter;
- Households with destitute person who is living on alms;
- Household headed by a widow or a single woman (unmarried/separated/deserted);
- Households headed by differently abled persons or individual having disability of above forty percent or terminally ill;
- Transgender person;
- A household headed by Minor or orphan;
- Households dependent on daily wage labour;
- Household with old persons, aged sixty years or above with no regular income, support or no assured means of subsistence;
- If all earning adult members in a household are irregular wagers, then that household shall be included; and
- Other vulnerable households such as slum dwellers, rag-pickers, unskilled workers, Shikara walas, Ponny walas, domestic workers, Sweepers etc.

##### II. For Rural Areas:-

- All Antyodaya Anna Yojana families;
- Households without shelter;
- Households with destitute person who is living on alms;
- Household headed by a widow or a single woman (unmarried/separated/deserted);
- Households headed by differently abled persons or individual having disability of above forty percent or terminally ill;
- Transgender person;
- A household headed by Minor or orphan;
- Household with old persons, aged sixty years or above with no regular income, support or no assured means of subsistence;
- Households dependent on agricultural labourers;
- Tribal Households with no regular source of income; and
- Other vulnerable households such as Shikara walas, Ponny walas, potters, cobblers, domestic workers, Sweepers etc.

#### b) Criteria for Exclusion:

- Households with one member as income or professional taxpayer;
- Businessmen having business turnover of Rs 25 lacs/year;
- Persons having landholding above 10 kanals in case of individuals and 20 kanals in case of joint family in urban areas. In rural areas, the same shall be 30 kanals and 50 kanals respectively (all based on self-declarations);
- All gazetted officers or equivalent ranks in Corporations, Boards, PSUs, etc.;
- All persons holding constitutional authority/positions;
- Any household having annual family income of more than 5 lacs.

Therefore, through the medium of this notice, it is notified that the eligible beneficiaries may contact the office of the concerned Tehsil Supply Officer for further details and, may apply for change of Category of Ration Card as per the aforementioned criteria by or before **23.05.2022** in the office of the concerned TSO.
