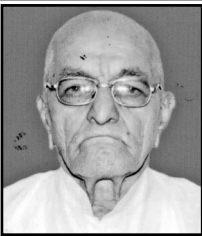

## CRIME REPORT

### 4 drug peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

**KUPWARA:** Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Thursday arrested 4 drug peddlers and recovered contraband substance from their possession.

As per details, acting on specific information, a party led by Incharge Police Post Hatmulla SI Lokesh Manhas under supervision of SHO Kupwara SI Mohd Rafiq Lone arrested 2 drug peddlers, who were identified as Javed Ahmad Wani, son of Mohd Yousaf and Rayees Ahmad Khan, son of Abdul Qayoom Khan, both residents of Halnatpora. The duo was arrested when they were on way to sell Charas among youth. They were shifted to police station where they remained in custody.

In another action, a police party led by SHO Police Station Kupwara SI Rafiq Lone under supervision of DySP DAR Sarfaraz Bashir established a checkpoint at Tikker. During checking, the team arrested two drug peddlers identified as Mohd Hussain Lone, son of Abdul Jabbar Lone, resident of Mirnag Hyhama and Manzoor Ahmad Khoja, son of Saifuddin Khoja, resident of Manwan Awoora. On search, contraband substance was recovered from their possession. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law were registered at Police Station Kupwara and further investigation started.

### Youth commits suicide, other dies in mishap

**SAMBAN:** A youth committed suicide while other died in a road mishap at Panchayat lower Bhajwal on Wednesday.

As per details, Sunny Raina (28 yrs), son of Late Gian Chand Raina, resident of village Kalideh was found hanging with a tree. His relatives shifted him to Sub District Hospital (SDH) Sunderbani where doctors declared him as brought dead. A suicide note was also found from deceased and it is suspected that a love angle might be behind the act.

Meanwhile, Banti Shoor, son of Yog Shoor (28 yrs) resident of village Ainpur Tlani, on way from Sunderbani to his house on bike, got hit by a vehicle and got injured. He was shifted to Sub District Hospital (SDH) Sunderbani where doctors declared him as brought dead.

### DMO Samba seizes Excavator, imposed fine on tractor-trolley

**SAMBAN:** To curb illegal mining practices in district Samba, the District Mineral Officer Mohammad Sayeed on Thursday conducted multiple inspections in Ghagwal area and imposed penalties on violators.

The DMO, under supervision of Deputy Commissioner, along with a team visited several areas of Ghagwal and seized an excavator (Pokland) machine involved in illegal mining. During inspection, they also seized material near one Crusher found illegally dumped. The DMO informed that a penalty was imposed on a tractor-trolley found illegally carrying earth material.

The DMO appealed to people to refrain from any type of illegal mining and contact control room in case of any illegal material demand. "Crusher unit holders will be held accountable if found raising minor minerals without permission," added DMO Samba.

### Enforcement teams recover Rs 12,500 fine from erring traders

**RAMBAN:** In view of ongoing Ramzan & forthcoming festivals, the Department of Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, along with other enforcement agencies on directions of Deputy Commissioner Ramban, Mussarat Islam, conducted a massive market checking drive across the district on Thursday.

A joint team of officers of FCS&CA, Legal Metrology Department and Police carried out market checking drives in Banihal and Ukhral market and recovered Rs 12,500 as fine from defaulters. Various other enforcement teams also checked markets in their jurisdictions and booked several erring shopkeepers found failing to maintain quality of food items, not displaying rate lists, selling expired products besides indulging in illegal profiteering.

### 35 bovines rescued, 4 smugglers arrested

**JAMMU/SAMBHA:** In a massive drive against bovine smuggling, Police on Thursday rescued 31 bovines during Naka checking at two different Nakas i.e., Ban Toll Plaza and Tawi bridge, in the jurisdictions of Police Station Nagrota and Police Post Sidhra. Three different vehicles (JK03E 3570, JK02AD 4442 and JK02AN 4710) were also seized. In this regard, FIR Nos. 163 & 64/2022 under sections 188/11 of PCA Act was registered at Police Station Nagrota and cognizance of case taken by Police Post Sidhra. The arrested accused were identified as Khurshied Ahmed, son of Ab Gani, resident of Assar Baggar Doda; Rafiqat Hussain, son of Mohd Kalu, resident of Sidhra and Mohd Qayoom, son of Bashir Ahmed, residenst of Jagti Jammu. The overall arrests and recoveries were made by SHO Nagrota Inspr Vishav Pratap Singh and Incharge Police Post Sidhra SI Majid Hussain under overall supervision of SDPO Nagrota Pardeep Kumar. The overall operation was done under guidance of SP Rural Sanjay Sharma.

District Police Samba also foiled an attempt to smuggle bovines by rescuing 4 bovines and arresting a bovine smuggler in jurisdiction of Police Station Ghagwal. Acting on information received through reliable sources regarding illegal transportation of bovines, a party from Police Station Ghagwal during surprise vehicle checking near main Chowk NIHW Ghagwal, intercepted a Tata Mobile load carrier (JK08H/8124) for checking.

During checking, 4 bovines were found laden inside it which were rescued while driver, identified as Shakeel Ahmed, son of Navab Din, resident of Rathian Tehsil and District Udhampur was arrested and FIR No. 64/2022 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act was registered against him.

### Missing girl traced, reunited with family

**JAMMU:** Police on Thursday traced a missing girl and reunited her with family. As per details, one missing report was lodged at Police Post Bathindi by legal heirs of a missing girl stating that girl went missing from her home. In this regard a missing report was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Post Bathindi under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari led by Incharge Police Post Bathindi PSI Mohd Younis Khanday, after putting in hectic efforts, traced the missing girl. Finally family of the missing girl was informed and she was reunited with her family after completing all legal formalities.

### Thief arrested, stolen car recovered

**JAMMU:** Police on Thursday solved a theft case by arresting an accused and recovered stolen car.

As per details, on April 17, 2022, a complaint was lodged by one Sameer Ahmed, son of Gafoor Ahmed, resident of Bharat Nagar Jammu regarding theft of his car (JK02AB/1104). In this regard, FIR No 111/22 under section 379 of IPC was registered at Police Station Bahu Fort and investigation started.

After this, a team of Police Post Narwal under supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari led by SHO Police Station Bahu Fort Inspr Nayat Ali assisted by Incharge Police Post Narwal SI Achal Rana, after putting in strenuous efforts, rounded up a suspect namely Hari Darshan, son of Late Anil Gupta, resident of Jain Bazar. During questioning, accused confessed his crime and on his disclosure stolen vehicle was also recovered.

### Rape case reported, accused at large

As per details, a woman, resident of Reasi, presently staying at Bhatindi lodged a complaint with police that one Anwar Ali, resident of Janipur had raped her on several occasion, on pretext of marriage but now he is refusing. It was also learnt that woman had acted in a movie also after which accused came in contact with her. After conducting medical examination of victim, police has registered a case and started manhunt to nab the accused.

### Mini-bus carrying Baratis turns turtle, 21 injured

**BISNHAH:** At least 21 Baratis were injured after a mini-bus, in which they were travelling, turned turtle in Awtaran village of Bishnah on Thursday.

As per details, a mini-bus which was carrying Baratis and was on its way to Slair village from Bari Brahmana, turned turtle in Bateyari village due to which 21 passengers got injured.

Locals along with police launched rescued operation and shifted all injured to hospital for treatment.

### 3 drug peddlers arrested with Ganja, heroin, intoxicants; woman held with illicit liquor

**KATHUA:** Acting sternly against the drugs menace and its propagators, District Police Kathua on directions of SSP R C Kotwal, arrested 3 drug peddlers in jurisdiction of Police Station Billawar near Bhini Bridge and Police Station Hiranagar near Sallan and recovered 268 gm Ghanja & 11 gm Heroin like narcotics, 38 nos Spasmo-Proxyvon Capsules (SPM+PRX) and 42 Nitravet-10 tablets from their possession. Further, a woman was also nabbed with 10 lts of illicit liquor near Chak Drab Khan Kathua.

As per details, a party from Police Station Billawar led by Insp Kuldeep Raj SHO Billawar under supervision of SDPO Billawar Arvind Kumar during patrolling/traffic checking duty at Bhini Bridge intercepted a suspect from a bus (HR38AB-1913) and while frisking, 268 gm Ghanja like narcotics along with 38 nos Spasmo Proxyvon capsules (SPM+PRX) & 42 Intravet-10 tablets were recovered from his possession. The accused, identified as Anil Kumar, son of Bodh Raj, resident of Dharamkot was arrested on spot and FIR No. 56/2022 under sections 08/20/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Billawar.

While in second instance, a team of Police Station Hiranagar led by Insp Sunil Kumar SHO Police Station Hiranagar under the supervision of SDPO Border Pankaj Soodan during patrolling duty near Sallan Dyalachak noticed the movement of a suspicious bike (Platina) being driven by one Rashid Ali, son of Shattu, resident of Jandriari Tehsil Rammagar while pillion-rider was identified as Murad Ali, son of Shafi Ahmed, resident of Ucha Pind Tehsil Ramkot at present Shapakiya. On checking, approximately 10-11 gm Heroin (Chitta) like narcotics was recovered from their possession. Duo was arrested and FIR No. 52/2022 under sections 8/21/22/29 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Hiranagar. Meanwhile, an information was received from reliable source that illicit liquor is manufactured near Chack Drab Khan and adjoining areas of Police Post Nagri. Acting swiftly, police team led by Insp Balram Sharma Incharge Police Post Nagri under supervision of DySP Headquarter Kathua Shammii Kumar during special checking/ patrolling duty, noticed a woman who was indulged in trade of selling illicit liquor.

On checking, approximately 10 lts illicit liquor was recovered from her possession. The woman, identified as Devo alias Gudi, wife of Late Dharam Paul, resident of Chack Drab Khan Tehsil & District Kathua, was arrested and FIR No. 161/2022 under sections 48(a) of Excise Act was registered against her at Police Station Kathua.
