

# Kashmiri Muslims safer in India in comparison to Pakistan: Tawdey

**SRINAGAR:** Kashmiri Muslims in India safer than in Pakistan, said BJP National General Secretary Vinod Tawdey while addressing a meeting with BJP leader of Kashmir unit, here in Tuesday.

Vinod Tawdey along with Co Incharge J&K Ashish Sood & BJP's General Secretary Organization Ashok Koul is on two days tour to Kashmir.

# MGR-47 delegation calls on delimitation commission, submits memo

**JAMMU:** MGR-47 Movement for Justice for PoJK Refugees of 1947 has submitted memorandum to Delimitation Commission seeking 24 seats for PoJK DPs in terms of Section 14(4)(a) and section 60 of J&K Reorganization Act, 2019 which provides that 107/114 should be total strength of assembly seats but 24 seats were wrongly deducted.

In a press statement issued here, Suchwant Singh, Chief Spokesperson MJR-47 impressed upon the Commission that allocation of 24 seats falls within the purview of Delimitation Commission as per act. He highlighted the irony of earlier Governments which defroze one PoJK seat for Mendhar where no PoJK DP reside. He further contended that political representation should be provided to women to accommodate one class of gender so that their issues are not ignored. He further that it is first and last opportunity for the people who have faced manifold worst turmoil than Kashmiri Pandits and still fought Pak Army to defend the nation. He demanded that full assembly seats may kindly be declared by allocating 24 seats for PoJK DPs settled in around 25 constituencies all along border running from Poonch to Kathua and even in other states of India.
