DC Kathua reviews arrangements for roll-out of 'Kissan Sampark Abhiyan' under HADP

KATHUA: To review and finalize the arrangements for smooth rollout of farmers' orientation programme (Kissan Sampark Abhiyan) under Holistic Agriculture Development Programme (HADP), a meeting of concerned officers was today convened under the chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner Kathua Rahul Pandey here in the Conference hall of the DC Office Complex.
