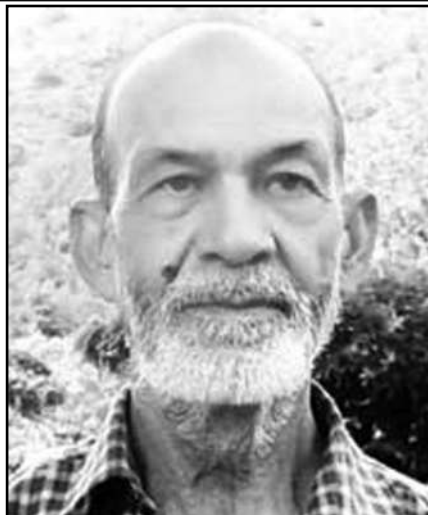
SHRADHANJALI

CRIME REPORT

Chenani bridge collapse: Injured succumbs, toll reaches 2

JAMMU: One more injured in Chenani bridge collapse on day of Baisakhi succumbed to injuries on Friday, thereby taking the death toll to two. The dead body has been handed-over to family after autopsy.

According to information, Chuni Ram, son of Sadhu Ram, resident Mantalai, who was admitted in GMC for treatment, succumbed on Friday. The police, after post-mortem, handed-over the body of deceased to family. Earlier a girl had died in the accident. With this death, the death toll has gone up to two.

Two drug peddlers arrested, 'Chitta' worth Rs 35,000 recovered

SAMBA: Under guidance of SSP Samba Benam Tosh, Police on Friday arrested two drug peddlers and recovering 'Chitta' worth Rs 35000 approximately from their possession.

The arrested drug peddlers were identified as Roshan Lal, son of Kartar Chand, resident of Agar Baba Jitto, district Reasi and Arun Kumar, son of Paras Ram, resident of Pharthal, district Reasi. FIR No 98/2023 under sections 8/21/22 of IPC has been registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana and investigation is underway. Vehicle used in commission of crime has also been seized by Police. The arrested peddlers used to purchase 'Chitta' from Samba and further sold it to addicts in Katra and adjoining areas of Reasi district on huge margins. They were arrested by a police team comprising SHO Bari Brahmana Sunil Sharma, PSI Rakesh Singh and PSI Shakti Singh under supervision of Additional SP Samba Surinder Choudhary.



Three drug peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

BARAMULLA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Friday arrested 3 drug peddlers and recovered contraband substance from their possession. As per

details, a party of Police Station Boniyar at a checkpoint established at Chellan Boniyar, arrested a drug peddler identified as Shakeel Ahmad, son of Mohd Hanief Kandal, resident of Mawer, Nowgam. During search, 127 gm Brown Sugar was recovered from his possession. The accused was shifted to police station where he remained in custody.

Similarly, a party of Police Post Mirgund during patrolling at Mirchinar Mirgund arrested 2 drug peddlers identified as Gh Mohammad Dar son of Ab Rehman Dar resident of Mirgund & Manzoor Ahmad Dar son of Assadullah Dar resident of Chenbal Mirgund. During search, 252 capsules of SpasmoProxynon Pw were recovered from their possession. They were shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective police stations and investigations have been initiated.

Highway theft case solved; 4 arrested, stolen items recovered

AKHNOOR: Police on Friday solved highway theft case by arresting 4 accused and recovered stolen items from their possession. As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Post Chowki Choura of Akhnoor Tehsil regarding theft of metal beam crash barrier along road side on National Highway near Chowki Choura. FIR No. 121 /2023 under section 379 of IPC was registered in Police Station Akhnoor and investigation started.

During sustained questioning, it came to light that they along with other associates namely Ranjot Singh, son of Didar Singh, resident of Nariya, Rajouri and Sukhvinder Singh, son of Attar Singh, resident of Maira Rajouri had stolen metal beam crash barriers from road-side on National Highway and accordingly 8 stolen metal beam crash barriers were recovered in presence of EMIC Chowki Choura. The overall recoveries were made under the supervision of SP Rural Rahul Charak.

Two dumpers seized for illegal mining
