"Despite SAC complete the regularization of all power engineers as a one-time exemption in two months, more than four years have elapsed and no tangible progress has been achieved till date. The majority of engineers including SEs and XEns are drawing the salaries of Junior Engineers. JKEEGA is dismayed over delay in promotions at all levels. The matter of the fact is that at present 700 posts are vacant at different levels with additional charge culture rampant across Department. The matter is so grave that the post of Managing Director, Transmission Corporation is

and 03 posts of Executive Directors (E) in DISCOMs and TRANSCO are vacant since their inception in Feb-Furthermore, 4 posts of Chief Engineers and 13 posts of Superintending Engineers functioning Corporations at highest level. The situation at lower management level is so grave that Executive Engineer's are holding charge of 3-4 Divisions spread across multiple Districts. Out of 124 Divisions, 58 Divisions are without Ex. Engineers. Besides 126 posts of Asstt. Executive Engineers and 161 Asstt. Engineers are also vacant which effects functioning at lower level.

JKEEGA requested the Lieutenant Governor to direct the concerned to resolve the issue of regularization and timely promotion at all levels.
