


## Cyber Cell Jammu solves online financial fraud

JAMMU: Cyber Cell of District Police Jammu solved four separate online cyber crime complaints.

In one complaint the complainant received a call from unknown person who asked him to download app namely YONO APP and defrauded an amount of Rs. 23,700. The complainant made transactions after which the fraudster demanded more amount and then complainant smelled fraud and reported the matter.

A complaint of financial fraud of Rs 61,000 in which the phone of complainant was hacked by unknown fraudster and an amount of Rs.61,000 withdrawn from his account through Google pay. Thereafter the fraudster switched off his phone.

Another complaint was received regarding financial fraud of Rs.56,000. The



exhibited hectic efforts which ultimately led to put on hold an amount of Rs 1,20,200/- out of 1,60,700/- in these four separate online cyber crime complaints. Further investigation is underway.

SSP Jammu Dr. Vinod Kumar reiterated in his appeal to the general public to remain extra vigilant and report promptly to the National Helpline number 1930 or Cyber Cell DPO Jammu helpline number 8899537995. ## GSTN says GSTR-1 filing due date to be extended till Apr 12

NEW DELHI: The GST Network (GSTN) on Thursday said the due date for filing return for outward supplies or GSTR -1 for March will be extended till April 12.

In a post on X (formerly Twitter), the GST Tech said the GSTN has noticed that taxpayers are facing difficulties in filing GSTR-1 intermittently since Wednesday due to technical issues leading to slow response on the portal.

"GSTN has accordingly recommended to @cbic\_india that the due date for filing of GSTR-1 for the monthly taxpayers be extended by a day ie till 12/4/24," the GST Tech said.

The due date to file GSTR-1 for a given tax period is 11th day of the succeeding month in case of taxpayers filing it monthly and the 13th day of month succeeding the end of every quarter in case of taxpayers filing quarterly.

#### ADVISORY FOR LIVESTOCK BREEDERS BEFORE MIGRATION TO HIGHLAND PASTURES

- The livestock breeders are advised to take the weather update into account before proceeding to Highland Pastures (HLPs).
- Culling of Old, infertile and weak animals must be done before migration.
- Shearing and recording of wool weights must be done at least 15 days prior to migration.
- Fire crackers should be taken along with which may be useful in wild animals attacks at HLPs.
- Salting of animals should be done at regular intervals.
- Faecal samples must be tested before conducting dosing/deworming under supervision of trained veterinarian.
- Hoof trimming and foot disinfection with copper sulphate and potassium permanganate must be done prior to HLP migration.
- Water should be given at regular intervals to livestock during migration to protect them from heat stress/dehydration.
- Vaccination against Foot and Mouth disease and Sheep Pox to both adult and young flocks should be carried out as per the devised schedule after consultation with a veterinarian.
- Cleaning, disinfection and rotational use of Sheep paddocks at HLP should be done at regular intervals to prevent diseases like Foot Rot.
- Ectoparasiticide dipping against diseases like Mange, Lice infestation must be done after shearing preferably on a sunny day.

#### PUBLIC NOTICE

Subject: Removal of Products 'Premix for FRK' and 'FRK' from Active Registrations-reg.

In order to strengthen the quality control mechanism of Fortified Rice [FR], Fortified Rice Kernels [FRK] and Premix for FRK, Food Safety and Standards Authority of India vide order No. IEC- 34011/1/2021-IEC-FSSAI-Part(6) dated 08.11.2023 has issued following directions:-

"a) FBOs manufacturing FRK and premix for FRK shall be required to obtain only FSSAI License [Central/State] and no new registration shall be allowed.

b) Further, existing FBOs who are operating under FSSAI Registration for the said products are directed to apply for Central/State License as per the eligibility. A transition time of three months is hereby given to existing Registered FBOs to shift to license and utilize the packaging and labelling materials, if any, failing which, the said two products shall be removed from their existing Registration Certificates [RC] to debar them from further manufacturing under RC, without any further notice."

Since the transition time as per the order dated: 08.11.2023 referred to above has ended on 08.02.2024 and subsequently the action mentioned on the removal of the products from the existing registrations is therefore effected forthwith.

Now, therefore, through the medium of this notice, all FBOs manufacturing, FRK and premix for FRK who have been still operating on Registrations, are hereby informed that:-

- Removal of the 'FRK' and 'Premix for FRK' from the Registration Certificate [RC] through system generated modification application has been done in FoSCoS.
- Modified Registration Certificates have been granted and sent to their registered email ids.
- FBO who had taken only one product either 'FRK' or 'Premix for FRK' manufacturing, their registrations shall be suspended by the concerned Registration Authorities, as by removing the product, registration certificate would remain product-less.
