NOTIFICATION

Subject: Lok Sabha Election 2024: Voting through Post of Ballots by Absentee voters in the category of Senior Citizens (AVSC). Persons with Disability (AVPD) and Covid-19 suspect or affected persons (AVCO) in District Kishtwar (04.Udhampur PC).

Rule 27A, defines 'Absentee Voter' as a person belonging to such class of Persons as may be notified. under clause (c) of Section 60 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 which also includes on elector belonging to the class of senior citizen or persons with disability (PwD) or the COVID 19 suspect or affected persons.

To make the process inclusive and accessible. Election Commission of India has extended its 'vote-from-home' facility to Persons with Disabilities (PWD) and senior citizens aged 85 and above and this move would allow 237 senior citizens and 84 persons with disabilities to cast their votes through postal ballots in district Kishtwar. Accordingly following steps have been taken for the smooth conduct of 'vote-from-home' for the absentee voters.

Intimation/application by voters for postal ballot and time limit for submission: Under rules Absentee Voters (Senior citizens and PwDs) have submitted applications in Form 12D within a period starting from date of commencement of election schedule up to the date of notification through Booth level officers who were deputed to all eligible Identified Absentee Voter (AVSC and AVPD) at their residences and took their consent to vote from home after filling Form-12D under rules and total 321 AVSC and AVPD applied for postal ballot facility to vote from their home as per the AC wise breakup:

Assistant returning officer 48-Inderwal, 49, Kishtwar and 50-Padder-Nagseni submitted the list of absentee Voters (AVSC, AVPD) on ANNEXURE-9 who have opted for voting through postal Ballot to Retruring Officer 04-Udhampur Parliamentary Constituency and the same was approved.

As per the instructions of Commission the approved list of all such notified absentee electors whose applications in Form 12D for availing Postal Ballot facility is being shared with the contesting Candidates/Election agents and their representatives of recognized political parties in printed hardcopy.

In view of the above, the process of delivering and collection of postal ballot from Absentee Voters in the categories of AVSC and AVPD has been drawn as per the SOP of ECI as the passing teams constituted and trained to visit places/residences of such category. The Separate polling team comprising of two officials, Micro-observer, security personnel, and videography team has been constituted.

Whereas Returning Office for 04-Parliamentary Constituency has fixed 14th and 15th April, 2024 for 'vote-from-home' for all such absentee voters. such electors shall also be intimated through BLOs/BLO supervisors about the said date and approximate time and visit of poll officers. The intimation is also being given through SMS on the mobile phone number wherever the same has been mentioned in the application in Form 12D by such electors. If the elector will not be present at the given address on the first visit, the polling team shall pay a second visit after leaving intimation about the time of second visit. If the elector will not be present even at the second visit, not further visit or action shall be taken by the authorities as per the instructions of commission.

Accordingly all the contesting candidates of 04-Udhampur PC for Lok Sabha Election 2024 are being informed through this notice about the schedule of visit for the delivery and collection of postal ballots for this category. they may, if desired, depute their authorized representatives (including BLAs), with prior intimation to the RO/AROs to watch the process. The appointment should be made by the candidate or the election agent in writing and under their signature. Form 10 (the form for appointment of polling agents in polling stations) may be used for appointment of such agent.
