2 notorious drug smugglers booked under PIT NDPS Act

BARAMULLA: Acting tough against drug peddlers and to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police booked two notorious drug smugglers under PIT NDPS Act in Baramulla after obtaining formal detention orders from competent authority. The notorious drug smugglers namely Showkat Ahmad Dar son of Mohd Abdullah resident of Ganiwani Tangmarg & Ghulam Mohammad Sheikh son of Abdul Samad resident of Mulgam Kunzer have been booked under PIT-NDPS Act after obtaining formal detention orders from the competent authority. The booked drug smugglers have been detained and subsequently lodged in Central Jail Kot-Balwal Jammu.

Pertinent to mention here that many cases are registered against these persons and were involved in disturbance of L&O and subversion. Despite their involvement

in many FIRs they did not mend their anti-national & anti-social activities.

Two absconders arrested

KULGAM: Continuing its crackdown against absconders, Police in Kulgam arrested two absconders who were evading their arrests from last many years. 2 vehicles seized, 2 persons arrested for illegal extraction & transportation of minerals

SOPORE: Cracking a whip on illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, police have seized two vehicles and arrested two drivers in Sopore. Theft case solved, two thieves arrested, stolen items recovered

SAMBA: Samba Police has worked out a theft cases registered at Police Station Ramgarh, arrested two thieves and recovered stolen items from their possession. On January 30, 2024, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Ramgarh by Joginder Singh, son of Qabila Singh and three others, all from village Gho Rakwalan tehsil Ramgarh district Samba, regarding theft of water pumps from their agriculture fields at village Gho Rakwalan by some unknown persons. During the course of investigation, police has arrested two accused namely Rahul Kundan, son of Jagdutt, resident of KotheyMaley, Arnia district Jammu and Jatin Basin alias Shubi, son of Rattan Lal, resident of Rathane, tehsil R.S Puradistrict Jammu in the instant case after hectic efforts. Further on their disclosure, stolen items i.e.04 Nos of water pumps have been recovered. Investigation of the case is going on.

5 bovine smugglers arrested

RAMBAN: Continuing its drive against the bovine smugglers and their propagators under Operation KAMDHENU, Ramban police under the supervision of SSP Ramban Anuj Kumar has foiled bovine smuggling attempts, arrested 05 bovine smugglers, rescued 89 bovines and seized five vehicles. A police team of Police station Batote headed by SHO Batote while performing vehicle checking duty at NHW Naka Nashri, intercepted two vehicles bearing registration JK02P 8337, Vehicle Temprrary No 6493 held two persons namely Puran Chand son of Chet Ram resident of Tringla, Tehsil Batote and Tousif Ahmed son of Mohd.Arif resident of Maitra Ramban. During checking 29 bovines were found laden inside both the vehicles which were tied in a cruel manner and were being transported illegally. Police Party of PS Chanderkote headed by SHO Chanderkote foiled two Bovine smuggling bids, intercepted 02 vehicles bearing registration Nos JK 19A 2658 and JK02AQ 8249 and held 02 persons namely Parvez Ahmed, son of Mohd Maroof, resident of Dhara Kunfer Chanderkote and Sajad Ahmed, son of Mohd Altaf, resident of Kaehwan Kehar pora Anantnag. During checking 33 bovines were found laden inside the two vehicles which were tied in a cruel manner and were being transported illegally. Police Party of PP Jawhar Tnnel headed by I/C PP foiled a Bovine smuggling bid, intercepted 01 vehicle bearing registration No JK 02DG 4813 and held 01 person namely Rafiq Ahmed S/O Farooq Ahmed R/O Ragura Jammu. During checking 27 bovines were found laden inside the vehicle which were tied in a cruel manner and were being transported illegally. As a result, a total of 89 bovine animals were rescued under the operation "KAMDHENU." Subsequently, FIR No. 42/2024 & 43/2024 were registered at Police Station Batote, FIR No. 43/2024 & 44/2024 at PS Chanderkote and FIR No 44/2024 at P/S Banihal under Sections 188 IPC, and under the Prevention of cruelty to Animals Act. The investigation has been initiated into these cases. 05 persons arrested and 05 vehicle involved in the commission of offence have been Seized. The successful rescue operation was conducted by Police parties led by SHO Police Station Batote and SHO PS Chanderkote and I/C PP JT under the supervision of Dyasp Hqrs Ramban, SDPO Banihal, Addl.SP Ramban, with the overall supervision by SSP Ramban.
