Various stakeholders, including officers and officials from the police, education, health, food and drug administration, municipalities, and other relevant sectors, actively participated in the one-

day training cum workshop. The training commenced with an insightful overview of the program by District Health Officer (DHO) Kulgam, Dr. Zahoor Ahmad. After this a detailed presentation on the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA) 2003, and vendor licensing protocols was

given by Dr. Mir Mushtaq, Nodal Officer of the Tobacco Control Programme at DHSK. Expert trainers from the Tobacco Control Programme, including Dr Mohd Naser and Er Zakir Hussain, provided in-depth presentations on topics such as Tobacco-Free Educational Institutions (TOFEI), the roles and


responsibilities of different stakeholders, and the online resources available for the Tobacco Control Programme in Jammu and Kashmir. During the session, speakers from the District Health Society, including Dr. Arjumand Rasool and Mussarif Ahmad, shed light on the adverse effects of tobacco products and secondhand

smoking, emphasizing the importance of awareness and enforcement. The event also featured an interactive question-and-answer session moderated by the State Nodal Officer for Tobacco Control Program where experts addressed numerous inquiries related to the Tobacco Control Programme and the COTPA Act.

Advisory for fruit growers of Jammu Division for the month of April.

The fruit growers of Jammu Division are hereby advised to adopt the following cultural and protective measures during the month of April 2024 for better management of their orchards.

- Keep the orchard area clean from all types of unwanted wild growth.
- Remove off shoots / water sprouts from the young plants as and when they emerge.
- Whitewash exposed trunks/stems with mixture of Slaked lime & Copper Sulphate in water (1:1:10) against Fungal diseases.
- Support the young fruit plants for their upright growth.
- Use insect traps such as light traps, yellow pan sticky traps and pheromones to check insect-pests attack.
- Use Bio-control agents such as Trichoderma to control soil borne diseases.
- Use Bio-fertilizers like Azotobactor, Azospirillum, Phosphobacteria, VAM etc. to enhance soil fertility.
- Vermicompost should be added in the soil to enrich soil with macro and micro nutrients thereby strengthening and increasing water holding capacity of soil.
- Spray Dimethoate @ 1ml/litre of water against Mango Hopper
- For the control of Mealy Bug, spray Imidacloprid 17.8 SL @ 0.5 ml/L or Dimethoate 30 EC @ 2 ml/L of water.
- Spray Dinocap @ 0.5ml/litre or Wettable Sulphur @ 2gm/ litre of water against Powdery Mildew.
- For control of Mango Anthracnose, Spray Carbendazim @ 1gm/litre of water at 15 days interval.
- Apply half of Urea in April after fruit set in Citrus Crop if not applied in March.
- Provide thatches/covers to the young Citrus plants but ensuring free circulation of air.
- Spray 2,4D @ 10 mg/litre of water or N.A.A. @ 30-40 mg / litre or Gibberalic acid @ 20-50 mg/litre of water against fruit drop in Citrus.
- Spray Zinc Sulphate @ 1.5gm/litre or Gibberalic acid @ 40mg/ litre of water at weekly intervals against Fruit cracking in Litchi
- For control of Anar Butterfly, spray Cypermethrin 10EC @ 7 ml / 10 litres of water and repeat the spray after 15 days.
- In Apple, Spray with Dodine 65WP @ 60gm/100 litres or Fenarimol 12 EC @ 40 ml/ 100 litres or Bittertanol 25 WP @ 50gm/100 litres of water against Scab at Pinkbud stage (Mid-April to ending April)
- Spray Chlorpyrifos 20 EC @ 100 ml/100 litres of water 3 to 4 days after spray against Scab as a prophylactic measure against Blossom Thrip in Apple.
- Spray Copper Fungicide @ 3gm/litre of water at post bloom/fruit set stage during 1st fortnight to 2nd fortnight


FRUIT PLANT NURSERIES

- Removal of off shoots/weeds and hoeing of nursery beds, mother plant basins.
- Drenching of young nursery stocks of Apple and Pear with Carbendazim @ 1gm /litre of water as Prophylactic measures against Damping off/ Root rot.
- Also, all the farmers are requested not to spray the pesticides during flowering / blossoms.

All the orchardists are requested to contact their nearest Horticulture office or dial Toll free No. 1800807050 for any query or feel free to dial 9149665493 for any Biotic or Abiotic issues in their orchard or bring infected samples of their crops to the Plant Health Clinic at Directorate of Horticulture TalabTillo, Jammu for diagnosis.
