KVK Reasi organises Field Day on Wheat Crop

REASI: Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), Reasi under the administrative control of Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology - Jammu (SKUAST-J)organised the field day on wheat crop here today at Jadh village in Reasi district of J&K which was attended by a number of tribal farmers of the area. The programme was organised under the dynamic stewardship of Vice Chancellor, Prof.B.N.Tripathi and able guidance of Director Extension, Prof.Amrish Vaid of SKUAST-J.

The programme was initiated by the Sr. Scientist and Head of KVK, Reasi, Dr. Banarsi Lal with the warm welcome of the farmers. He briefed the significance of field day on wheat crop in the village and its impact on the adjoining villages. He highlighted the high yielding varieties of wheat crop for the area and added that the farmers should adopt latest technologies in their fields so that they can enhance their crops production and productivity. He emphasized on Integrated Nutrient Management and Integrated Weed Management in wheat crop. He discussed

the remedial measures of different diseases in wheat crop. He also recommended certain disease resistant varieties for the area. He elaborated the control measures of wheat diseases like loose smut and yellow rust of wheat. He highlighted the climate resilient agriculture and stressed on the timely weed management in wheat crop so as to get good results. He also suggested the control measures of rodents and termite in the wheat crop. He guided the farmers on the organic practices required in wheat cultivation. A field visit was also arranged to popularize the

improved variety of wheat crop during the programme. On field results of improved variety of wheat crop were also demonstrated to the farmers and the farmers were convinced to adopt the technologies recommended by KVK. In this programme farmers asked various queries which were answered by the scientists in a satisfactorily way. In this programme the beneficiaries shared their experiences about the Front Line Demonstrations (FLDs) on wheat crop laid by KVK, Reasi and appreciated the KVK efforts for the promotion of new agricultural technologies in the area. KVK has laid Front Line Demonstrations (FLDs) on wheat crop in the area. During the programme, the progressive farmer Mohd. Altaf was also present who shared his experiences on progressive farming with other farmers of the area. The programme was assisted by Manohar Lal and concluded by Mohd. Director Agriculture Jammu concludes two day extensive tour of District Udhampur

UDHAMPUR: Director Agriculture Production and Farmer Welfare, Jammu, Arvinder Singh Reen, accompanied by a team of officers, recently concluded a two day extensive tour of Udhampur district. The primary objective of this tour was to evaluate the progress of various Farmer Welfare Schemes and field activities being undertaken by the Department of Agriculture.
On the first day of the tour, Director Agriculture Jammu made a significant visit to the Chief Agriculture Office in Udhampur: Engaging in productive interactions with the CAO office staff and the field staff, discussions ranged from field issues to the review of projects under the Holistic Agriculture Development Programme (HADP).
During the tour, Director Agriculture Jammu inspected several crucial facilities, including the Government

Agriculture Engineering Workshop and the Mushroom Development Officer premises in Udhampur. These visits aimed to assess the infrastructure and efficiency of these establishments in supporting agricultural endeavors in the region.
Furthermore, Director Agriculture Jammu undertook an inspection of the Soil Testing Lab in Udhampur; reviewing equipment, procedures, and staff competence within the lab. He also visited the Hi-Tech polyhouse owned by Hansraj son of Kashmiri Ram in village Ballian Subdivision, Udhampur; to evaluate the progress of the polyhouse under the HADP. Continuing on the second day, Director Agriculture conducted a review meeting with the staff at the Sub Divisional Agriculture Office in Ramnagar. The meeting included discussions and feedback on various Farmer Welfare Schemes, including HADP and

social sector schemes like PMKISAN, PMFBY and KCC.
During the tour, Director Agriculture Jammu also inspected the IFS model unit under HADP situated in Marta village, Amroh town, to assess its implementation and effectiveness in enhancing farmers' livelihoods. He also visited the medicinal and aromatic farm in Ineha, sub-division Ramnagar. The main focus was to inspect the medicinal and aromatic plants nursery developed in public sector under HADP.
