CHANDIGARH: The AAP's Raj Kumar Chabbewal is banking on the Bhagwant government's schemes, especially providing free electricity and setting up aam aadmi clinics, to win the Hoshiarpur Lok

A radiologist by profession, the former two-time MLA is contesting the parliamentary polls on an AAP ticket from Hoshiarpur, currently represented by the BJP's Som Parkash.

Chabbewal last month quit the Congress and joined

The 54-year-old also resigned as MLA from the Chabbewal constituency in Hoshiarpur district. He was the deputy leader of opposition in the Punjab Assembly when he quit.

Chabbewal first became an MLA from the Chabbewal assembly segment in 2017 and retained the seat in the

He had unsuccessfully contested the Lok Sabha elections from Hoshiarpur in 2019, losing to Parkash

IAF helicopter roped in to douse forest fires in Uttarakhand

DEHRADUN: An IAF helicopter was pressed into service on Saturday to extinguish the raging forest fires in Uttarakhand's Nainital district, Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami said.

The situation in the district worsened on Friday with the flames reaching the High Court Colony in the Pines area. An MI-17 helicopter collected water in a Bambi Bucket from Bhimtal lake and poured it over the burning forests of Pines, Bhumiadhar Jvolikot Narayan Nagar, Bhawali, Ramgarh and Mukteshwar areas of the district, officials

Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami said all efforts are being made to bring the fires under control and it will be done soon

"An IAF helicopter has already started dousing the fires," he said.

Dhami said he will hold a meeting with forest officials in Haldwani later in the day to review the situation.

Taarak Mehta Ka Ooltah Chashmah actor goes missing, Delhi Police lodges FIR

NEW DELHI: Delhi Police on Saturday lodged an abduction case over the disappearance of actor Gurucharan Singh of the famous TV serial 'Taarak Mehta Ka Ooltah Chashmah' fame, officials said.

Multiple teams have been formed to find the 50-year-old actor, who is a Delhi resident, after he went missing five days

He was last seen near the Delhi airport with a backpack, the police said citing a CCTV footage.

An FIR has been lodged under Section 365 (abduction) and and an investigation has been launched into the matter, they added.

"Actor Gurucharan Singh who plays the role of 'Roshan Singh Sodhi' in the TV serial 'Taarak Mehta Ka Ooltah Chashmah' went missing on April 22 evening," Deputy (Southwest) Rohit Meena said.

"Singh's father lodged a missing complaint saying his son had left for Mumbai on April 22at 8.30 pm. He has been missing since then," Meena said.

The actor had left his home here to take a flight for Mumbai. But he did not reach Mumbai, neither he returned to his home and his phone was also unreachable, the complaint

The officer said the police are investigating the entire matter from every angle.

NEW DELHI: The CBI has

taken over the probe into the killing of a 22-year-old man during communal violence in Chhattisgarh's Bemetara district last year and registered an FIR against 12 people, officials said on Saturday. Bhuneshwar Sahu was

killed in the violence that erupted in Biranpur village on April 8, 2023, after an altercation between schoolchildren from two communities. On April 11, Biranpur residents Rahim Mohammad (55) and his son Idul Mohammad (35) were found dead a few kilometers away from the village and there were multiple injuries on their bodies.

According to procedure, the CBI re-registered the state police FIR that named 12 people as accused in the



case, the officials said

In a statement, the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) said, "It was alleged that children studying in class 7-8 of a village were returning from school, when boys of a community working at a junk shop beat them up, on which a meeting was

"It was also alleged that when the victim along with his friends went to the locality of the said community in

the afternoon, the members of the community started pelting stones from the roof. The victim fell down and as a result sustained head injuries," it said.

The accused and others allegedly killed the victim using a knife and other weapons, the statement said. During investigation, the

local police found criminal evidence against the 12 people named in the FIR and arrested them, it said, Police

had filed a charge-sheet against all the accused but the probe was kept open.

In February during an assembly Session, Ishwar Sahu raised the incident in the House through a calling attention motion questioning the government about a CBI probe in his son's killing.

He had said his son was killed on April 8 last year and only 12 people were arrested in the case even though the names of 36 individuals accused in the incident were then submitted to authorities

The BJP government, which had assured Ishwar Sahu of a CBI probe, sent the recommendation for it on April 25, and it was received by the agency thenext day.
