

DEO Kupwara holds meeting with AROs, Dist Officers, Principals

The DEO directed the concerned Officers to work with utmost coordination to complete all assigned tasks related to the conduct of the Lok Sabha elections-2024. She stressed that Assured Minimum Facilities (AMF) should be ensured as per norms of ECI. She directed HOIs to cross check the AMFs at respective Polling stations, besides concerned AROs will oversee the inspection of AMFs in

Polling stations. She further directed the concerned to ensure readiness of all arrangements for polling parties, and security staff. The DEO also enjoined upon the concerned to take up all necessary arrangements for facilitating voting by Postal Ballots by various categories of Voters including service voters, personnel on Poll Duty, Employees of Essential service Departments, migrant electors, absent electors, etc so that they cast their vote in upcoming Lok Sabha

Election without any difficulty. The DEO directed the concerned to establish Postal ballot facilitation centres for every assembly segment. She asked the concerned Nodal Officers to expedite the process of imparting Election related Trainings to the Poll Staff and ensure no additional assignments are allocated to Polling staff. The meeting was attended by AROs, District Officers, Election Nodal officers and Principals of Degree Colleges and Higher Secondary Schools.

Kejriwal spends restless night in Tihar, his sugar level low, say jail officials

NEW DELHI: Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, who has been remanded in judicial custody till April 15 in the excise policy case, paced up and down his 14X8 feet cell on his first night in Tihar jail, managing only to sleep for a while, a prison official said. According to prison officials, Kejriwal was brought to Tihar jail at 4 pm on Monday and was medically examined before being sent to his cell where he is staying alone. His sugar level was below 50 at that time and medicines were given to him on the advice of doctors, he said. India's first sitting chief minister to be lodged at Asia's largest prison has been kept in jail number two. His wife and children are likely to meet him on

Tuesday, an official said. The chief minister was given tea in the afternoon and was served home-cooked food for dinner, a source said on Tuesday, adding that he has been given a mattress, blankets and two pillows. He slept on a cement platform for some time and was seen walking in his cell late in the night, the source said. In the morning, Kejriwal's sugar level was still low and he is under the watch of Tihar jail doctors, prison officials said. He is allowed to have home-cooked food in lunch and dinner and it will be served daily, till his sugar level comes to normal, they said. Kejriwal, who is also the AAP national convener, meditation in his cell in the morning after which he was served tea and two biscuits, sources said.

Two personnel from Tihar Jail Security and a jail warder have been deployed outside his cell. Jail authorities are keeping a watch on him through the CCTV cameras, while a quick reaction team has also been deployed near his cell, officials said. The books he had requested Ramayana, Mahabharata, and 'How Prime Ministers Decide' -- have been provided to him. He has also been allowed a religious locket that he wears. As per the rules, Kejriwal has given a list of six people whom he would like to meet. The list includes his wife Sumita Kejriwal, their son and daughter, his private secretary Bibhav Kumar and AAP general secretary (organisation) Sandeep Pathak. A Delhi court on Monday

sent Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal to judicial custody till April 15, noting the Enforcement Directorate's contention that his release could hamper the investigation into the Delhi excise policy-linked money laundering case. Underscoring that Kejriwal was misleading it, the federal probe agency said it was still investigating the chief minister's role, unearthing the further proceeds of crime and identifying the other persons involved with the activities related to the proceeds.

J-K: Mortar shell destroyed in controlled blast in Samba

SAMBA/JAMMU: An mortar shell was found in a field and was later destroyed in a controlled explosion by a bomb disposal squad in Jammu and Kashmir's Samba district on Tuesday, police said. The mortar shell, which was old and rust-

ed, was noticed by a person working in his fields at Rajpura village in Ghagwal, a police official said. He said a police party along with a BDS team was rushed to the scene and the mortar shell was later destroyed at the scene without causing any damage.
