

Div Com reviews arrangements for Eid, Baisakhi, Navratra, other religious occasions

SRINAGAR: The Divisional Commissioner (Div Com) Kashmir, Vijay Kumar Bidhuri on Wednesday convened a meeting of Deputy Commissioners and officers of various departments to review the arrangements for the celebration of upcoming religious festivals by different communities including Muslims, Sikhs and Hindus.

The Div Com reviewed comprehensive arrangements for the observance of Shab-e-Qadr, Friday following and the celebration of Eid ul Fitr, Baisakhi and Navratra in the valley.

Addressing the meeting, Bidhuri enjoined on all the officers to ensure availability of all requisite services and facilities to the people including electricity, drinking water, sanitation, cleanliness, food items and other essentials.

He also directed for making adequate arrangements for smooth movement of vehicles, availability of SRTC vehicles and parking space.

Further, he directed DCs to visit the prominent religious places of all the communities in their respective districts and ensure

all the facilities to the devotees. Earlier, Div Com Kashmir conducted an extensive visit of Dargah Hazratbal Shrine, Imambara Zadibal and Jamia Masjid Nowhatta to take the stock of arrangements for the celebration of Eid ul Fitr and observance of Shab-I-Qadir and Friday following for the convenience of devotees.

He was accompanied by Deputy Commissioner Srinagar, Dr Bilal Mohi ud din; Director Health services Kashmir; SSP Traffic, Srinagar; Joint Commissioner SMC; CE, KPDCL; CE Srinagar Smart City Limited and other senior officers of line departments of Waqf Board, PHE and other concerned departments.

During his visit to Dargah, Div Com directed concerned officers to make comprehensive arrangements for uninterrupted electricity and water supply besides opening of newly constructed washrooms for public utility in view of religious festivals.

He also directed the operation of water fountain in the premises of Shrine and grass cutting for the enhancing the landscape of parks.

He instructed the Health Department for establishment of a health camp at

the shrine with a dedicated medical team besides exhorted to SMC for conducting sanitation drives in the vicinity as well as in the premises of Harzatbal Shrine.

While visiting Imambara Zadibal, Div Com took the stock of arrangements and listened to the demands of locals there. On the occasion, Div Com directed shifting of street light poles to the periphery of premises for increasing the space, besides he also directed the concerned departments for addressing the issue of water supply. He gave directions to the concerned officers for making elaborate arrangements regarding observance of religious occasions.

At Jamia Masjid, he interacted with the members of the community and listened to their issues. On the occasion he instructed all line departments to ensure all the services to the devotees and maintain liaison with the members of the local community.

He also directed the operation of water fountain in the premises of Shrine and grass cutting for the enhancing the landscape of parks.

Subject: Final Show Cause Notice for personal appearance.

- Whereas, on 24.06.2021, while your posting in Hqr. Coy of this unit at Battalion Hqrs. you left your legitimate duties un-authorizedly, your absence was recorded in Unit Daily Diary Vide Report No.17 dated 24.06.2021 at 2000 hours.
- Whereas, you did not respond to the communication either in writing or telephonically of Battalion Admn. and you were placed under Suspension vide this office Order No. 357 of 2021 dated 19.07.2021 and a proper Departmental Enquiry into your conduct was initiated and entrusted to Adjutant of this unit .
- Whereas, after hard efforts of this unit you finally resumed duties in writing on 10.02.2022 vide DD report No. 19 Dated 10.02.2022 at 1435 hours, after remaining un-authorizedly absent from duties for the period w.c.f 24.06.2021 to 10.02.2022 i.e (231) Days.
- Whereas, just remaining present at Battalion Headquarters for only three days after resumption of duties, you left again un-authorizedly on 14.02.2022, during Suspension period and your instant absence during Suspension was recorded in Unit Daily Diary vide DD report No. 12 dated 14.02.2022.
- Whereas, a Final Show Cause Notice was served to you vide this office No.Estt/PF-604/IRP-10th/2023 /15181-92 dated 24.07.2023 communicating therein to you as to why you should not be Removed from Government Services on account of your prolonged absence.
- Whereas, the said notice was got published in Daily Excelsior Jammu on Thursday, July 27,2023, informing you through print media also regarding the proposed action.
- Whereas, on seeing the paper cutting of date and proposed action to be taken against you, you approached to DIG IRP Kashmir and got directions to the then Commandant of this unit for allowing you to resume your duties vide IRROK No. IRROK/Estt-05/2023/8379 dated 10.08.2023. Accordingly as desired by the higher authorities, you were allowed to resume your duties on 11.08.2023 on the same application /document which was forwarded to this unit by IRROK, which was diarized in Unit Daily diary vide DD report No.16 dated 11.08.2023, thereby you absented second time during suspension period for the period w.e.f. 14.02.2022 to 11.08.2023 i.e (544) Days.
- Whereas, you again (3rd Instance) left Battalion Hqrs. Un-authorizedly on 29.08.2023 and accordingly your un-authorized absence was recorded in unit daily Diary report No. 27 at 0600 hours and since then you are still at large.
- Whereas, on this 3rd instance of absence during suspension period, you were informed by the Enquiry Officer vide his No. ADJ/IRP-10th /23/247 dated 30.11.2023 through your concerned Police Station (P/S Rajbag, Kathua) to attend his office for facing the D.E, which you failed at all.
- Whereas, Show Cause Notice was again served to you vide this office No. Estt/PF-604/IRP-10th /2024/1720-30 dated 25.01.2024, communicated therein to you as to why you should not be removed from Govt. Services.
- Whereas, neither you have responded to Show Cause Notice nor resumed your duties till date.
- Whereas, the nominated Enquiry Officer thought it prudent that since you are not responding to the communication made by him or this office and accordingly proceeded further into the D.E initiated against you by taking an Exparte decision and prepared findings and submitted the same to this office vide his No. ADJ/IRP-10th /Find/24/59 dated 27.03.2024, recommended therein that the period of your un-authorized absence /suspension w.e.f. 24.06.2021 to 10.02.2021 & Period of Un-authorized absence/suspension w.e.f 14.02.2022 to 11.08.2023 may be treated as on DIENSNON on the principle of NO WORK NO PAY and you should be REMOVED from Govt Services w.e.f. 29.08.2023 i.e. the date you left the Battalion Hqrs. un-authorizedly during suspension period 3rd time .
- Whereas, on perusal of previous service profile it is evident that during your short span of service tenure till date you have been awarded (01) major punishment in the shape of Stoppage of Annual Increment for a period of one year in the year 2015 and also during short service tenure (164) days of your service have been treated as Dienston on three occasions, which too makes it clear that you have not remained duty bound in past also.
- Whereas, the act on your part as enumerated above, is a severe service misconduct/deliction of duties and is unbecoming on your part. It not only speaks of your disinterest to serve the department anymore, but also warrants severe action to be taken against you under Rules.

Consequent upon the above, before the recommendations of the Enquiry Officer are agreed to and in order to avoid any miscarriage of Natural Justice and in light of Sub-Rule (11) (2) of Rule 359 of J&K Police Manual I Mubassir Latifi IPS, Commandant IRP-10th Bn. issue this Final Show Cause Notice to you, "as to why a departmental action as envisaged under Rule 339 of J&K Police Manual shall not be taken against you, i.e. why you should not be Removed from the Govt. Services on account of your previous blamished service profile as well as repeated/prolonged un-authorized absence from duties. In that case before the proposed decision is endorsed /issued, you are called upon to cause your personal appearance, before the undersigned within (07) days from the date of issuance of this Notice, if you choose so having regard to the principle of Natural Justice and to defend yourself. If you fail to appear within the stipulate period, it shall be presumed that you have nothing to say in this behalf and are not interested to serve the department anymore and accordingly, you will be REMOVED from Govt.
