# CRIME REPORT

## Major bovine smuggling attempts foiled, 43 bovines rescued, 5 smugglers arrested

### STATE TIMES NEWS

**SAMBA/REASI:** Continuing its drive against bovine smugglers and their propagators, Samba Police has foiled two major bovine smuggling attempts during the intervening night of April 03/04, 2024 in the jurisdiction of Police Station Bari Brahmana & Police Station Samba, arrested two bovine smugglers and rescued thirty six bovines.

A police party of Police Station Bari Brahmana headed by SHO PS Bari Brahmana during vehicle checking at Naka Balole Bridge Bari Brahmana, intercepted a truck bearing registration No. UP12T-6057 coming from Jammu side for its checking. During checking of said vehicle, twenty two bovines were found laden inside the vehicle which were tied in a cruel manner and were being transported illegally without any valid permission.

The bovine smuggler identified as Mustkim, son of Abdul Wahid, resident of Mahank Mau district Saharanpur (UP) has been arrested.

A case FIR No.45/2024 U/S 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act has been registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana and investigation started.

Likewise, a police party of Police Post Goran headed by Incharge PP Goran has successfully foiled another major bovine smuggling attempt, arrested bovine smuggler and rescued fourteen bovines which were being smuggled by foot via DhakiKhad area.

The arrested bovine smuggler has been identified as Altaf Hussian, son of Haji Yousof, resident of Surara district Samba. A case FIR No.88/2024 U/S 188 IPC has been registered at Police Station Samba and investigation started.

Continuing special drive against the bovine smuggler under Operation Dhenu teams of District Police Reasi laid special nakas, arrested 03 bovine smugglers while rescuing 07 bovines being illegally transported by them, and seized 02 vehicles used for transporting the animals.

Team of Police check Post Balini, during checking, intercepted a Tata mobile bearing registration No. JK14E-0359 transporting the animals without permission and rescued 03 bovines from the possession of Bovine smuggler namely Shokat Ali, son of Mohd Shafi, resident of Simbal Chowha Tehsil & District Reasi.

In this regards a case FIR No. 95/2024 U/S 188 IPC has been registered at Police Station Katra and investigation initiated. Vehicle Tata mobile got seized and both the accused got arrested in the instant case.

In another incident Team of Police Check Post Balini, during naka checking foiled bovines smuggling attempt, intercepted a one Tata Mobile bearing registration No. JK20C 1172 and rescued 04 bovines from the possession of Bovine smuggler namely Mohd Saleem, son of Bashir Ahmed, resident of Karua Kotli Tehsil Katra & District Reasi and co-driver namely Abdul Gani, son of Mohd Hussain, resident of Karua Tehsil Katra and District Reasi.

In this regards case FIR No. 96/2024 under sections 188 IPC stands registered at Police Station Katra and investigations initiated.

## Theft case solved, accused arrested

**BUDGAM:** Police solved theft case by arresting an accused person and recovered stolen property from his possession.

Police Post Soibugh received a complaint from one lady who is a resident of Soibugh stating there in that some unknown persons have barged into her house and stole cash and golden ornaments. Upon this information, a case vide FIR No. 103/2024 under relevant section of law was registered at Police Station Budgam and investigation was set into motion.

During the course of investigation, several suspects were brought for questioning. During questioning, one suspect identified as Furqan Ahmad Malik son of Manzoor Ahmed Malik resident of Soibugh admitted his involvement in the commission of crime. On his disclosure, stolen cash of Rs 6,500/- were recovered from his possession. He has been arrested in the instant case and further investigation is going on.



## 13 vehicles seized, 8 drivers arrested for illegal extraction & transportation of minerals

**BARAMULLA:** Acting tough against the persons involved in illegal extraction and

transportation of minerals, police have seized 8 vehicles and arrested 8 drivers in Baramulla.

Police parties under the supervision of SDPO Tangmarg, Pattan & Kreeeri assisted by SHO PS Pattan/Kunzer, IC PP Kungambara & Wagoora seized 8 vehicles (3 Tippers, 4 Tractors, 1 Excavator) & arrested 8 drivers at Vizer, Palpora, Khore Sherabad & Kunzer for illegal extraction and transportation of minerals. The accused drivers have been identified as Zahoor Ahmad Malik son of Mohd Abdullah resident of Drangbal Baramulla, Naveed Ahmad Dar son of Gh. Mohammad resident of Jal Sheeri Baramulla, Altaf Ahmad Lone son of Ghulam Mohammad resident of Nuner Ganderbal, Mehraj Din Dar son of Mohd Altaf Dar resident of Kralpora, Arshid Ahmad Wani son of Abdul Hameed resident of Shirpora Pattan, Aarif Ahmad Shah son of Abdul Rashid resident of Khore Sherabad & Irshad Ahmad Kambay son of Ghulam Mohiuddin resident of Takiya Batpora.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective police stations and further investigation have been taken up.

People are requested not to indulge in any kind of illegal mining activities from any Nallah as it is the violation of Government rules. Persons found indulging in illegal mining activities shall be dealt as per law.

Meanwhile, Police teams of Police Post Phallian Mandal, Police Post Chinore acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at multiple locations within their respective jurisdictions and seized 05 vehicles involved in illegal mining.

Tractors with Chassis no MBNAALXBKJH03972; MBNGB53ACLCD92123; QAF550025133 seized by Phallian Mandal police and JK02CM-2460 (Dumper) 2. JK02CR-6028 (Dumper) by Chinore Police.

The vehicles were found loaded with minor mineral sand without FormA/permission and so were detained.

## Illegal properties of notorious drug peddler worth Rs 20 lakh attached

**BARAMULLA:** Continuing its action against drug peddlers, Police in Baramulla attached properties (1 Kanal & 10 Marlas Land and single-story residential house worth approx. ₹20 lacs) belonging to notorious drug peddler namely Farooq Ahmad Mir son of Gh. Mohiuddin Mir resident of Zaspura Tangmarg, District Baramulla.

The action was taken under sections 68-E read with 68-F (1) of NDPS Act of 1985 & is linked with case FIR No.50/2019 & 55/2023 u/s 8/20, 29 NDPS Act of PS Tangmarg & case FIR No. 142/2022 u/s 8/20 NDPS Act of PS Kunzer.

The property was identified as illegally acquired property during the course of investigation/enquiry conducted by Police. The property was prima facie acquired from illicit trafficking in Narcotic drug and Psychotropic substances by the drug peddler.

This operation reaffirms the commitment of Police to combat the drug menace. Local people of the area hailed the initiative of Police.

## Drivers booked for rash, negligent driving, overloading in passenger vehicles

On this, a case in FIR 36/2024 U/Ss 279/336/194A, 184 MV Act was registered at police station Kandi and investigation of the case is going on.
