DGP J&K sanctions Rs. 1.31 cr of welfare loan in favour of 102 police personnel

JAMMU: Continuing with its endeavour to provide financial assistance to the police personnel, the Director General of Police, J&K, R.R. Swain has sanctioned Rs 1.31 crore as welfare loan in favour of 102

Police personnel in order to meet their urgent financial requirements. Vide an order of PHQ, a welfare loan of Rs 1.14 crore has been sanctioned in favour of 88 Police personnel to meet the expenses on account of their self-marriage or marriage of their wards. The amount sanctioned

ranges from rupees one lakh to one lakh fifty thousand. Similarly, Rs 15.50 lakh has been sanctioned in favour of 11 Police personnel for their wards' higher education purpose and the amount ranges from rupees fifty thousand to rupees one lakh fifty thousand. Besides rupees fifty thousand

each has been sanctioned in favour of three Police personnel for performing religious obligations. Pertinently this year till date welfare relief and welfare loan amounting to the tune of over rupees 7.30 crore has been sanctioned in favour of 537 Police personnel including SPOs.

Surveillance & monitoring to be intensified in border, rural areas

These beat booths shall be designated in each beat of all the police stations to make accessibility of police more frequent & meffective. This will also ensure prompt response and mobility in case of exigencies as there shall be more frequent touring and visits of police officers and officials in these beat booths .

Rural areas being vast and far are hard to dominate effectively and this *beat booth system* shall enhance capabilities of police for Rural patrolling. And it will definitely help in better monitoring and surveillance of areas and persons with suspicious backgrounds with active participation of public.

Beat Booths shall have detailed information of all villages and mohallas and also contact numbers under provision of *Dial your police station & Dial your police Subdivision* for the assistance of general public. The flexes/ boards mentioning beat number and other details were affixed by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Sharma & SHO Akhnoor Tariq Ahmad under supervision of SP Rural Brijesh Sharma.

The aim of designating beat booths is to strengthen the policing at ground level and to make redressal of public grievances at their doorsteps.

JKTPO, Invest India (DPIIT) organise Organic Certification program for walnut growers at Rajouri

JAMMU: The Jammu and Kashmir Trade Promotion Organisation (JKTPO) organised an awareness program at Rajouri under the National Programme for Organic Production (NPOP), with focus on obtaining organic certification for walnut, an ODOP product of Rajouri district. This initiative is a collaboration with the Invest India, DPIIT (Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade), Ministry of Commerce and Industries.

The workshop's objective was to deliver certification and training to farmers who are already involved in producing organic walnuts but lack the necessary certification to authenticate their products. This initiative is aligned with JKTPO's mission to promote ODOP products in Jammu and Kashmir and raise awareness among walnut growers.

Besides, the event was attended by the Chief Horticulture officer, District Horticulture officer, government officials, walnut growers, representatives from JKTPO, Invest India and the certifying agency Aditi Organic Certifications Private Limited.

Reference Court didn't consider commercial potential of land acquired: HC

JAMMU: Justice Sanjeev Kumar of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court, while deciding the appeal of land accquisition, on Saturday observed that Reference Court did not take into consideration the commercial potential of the land acquired and fixed the market value on mere conjectures and guess-work.

This significant order has been passed in the petition filed by Paras Ram & ors against the judgment/award dated 27th August, 2014 passed by the learned District Judge, Jammu ["the Reference Court"] in file No.18/LA Act titled Paras Ram and others v. Collector Land Acquisition (ACR, Jammu) and another, whereby the market rate of the acquired land in village Satwari has been enhanced from Rs. 1,45,000 per kanal to Rs. 2,07,500 per kanal.

Justice Sanjeev Kumar, after hearing Adv GS Thakur for the appellants, Sr. AAG Monika Kohli for the UT and Advocate Inderjeet Gupta with Adv Yatin Mahajan for the Airport Authority of India, observed that in the instant case, there is admittedly a gap of nine years and, therefore, having regard to the guidelines laid down in the aforesaid judgments and also the special factors existing in the instant case, this Court is of the opinion that enhancement to the market rate of acquired land @ 12% with cumulative effect would be just and fair compensation and would meet the ends of justice. The special factors which existed in this case and have weighed heavily with this Court are that the land was situated in an urban area and had high commercial potential. This Court also took judicial note of the fact that

with the existence of airport in the vicinity, entire area had turned into a commercial hubli. There has been a steep upward trend in the prices of the land in vicinity.

For the foregoing reasons, the award passed by the Reference Court is modified. The market value of the acquired land shall be fixed and taken as Rs.2,48,466/- per kanal. Rest of the award passed by the Reference Court shall, however, remain intact. The enhanced amount shall be payable along with solatium @15% and interest @ 6% per annum, to be reckoned from the date of taking possession of the acquired land for a period of one year and @ 10% per annum till the enhanced amount is actually paid to the appellants. The respondents shall do well to complete the entire exercise and disburse the amount within a period of two months.

and the young generation is affected by it. The Detaining Authority, after recording its subjective satisfaction, has passed the impugned order of detention. The provisions, as contained in NDPS Act, state that if the detaining authority is satisfied to prevent any person from indulging in illicit trafficking in narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, it would make an order directing that person to be detained. The detaining authority was aware that deteneue was engaged in illicit trafficking of drugs and these acts were against the general public, therefore, making it necessary to detain the detenu. . In view of the aforesaid, Court do not find any ground to interfere in the impugned order of detention, thus, there is no merit in this petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.

in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (PITNDPS) Act, the detenu was detained under Section 3 of the Prevention of Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1988, vide order dated September 14, 2023. This order of detention has been assailed by the detenu through his wife-Nekha Devi. Justice Sindhu Sharma after hearing Adv Anmol Sharma for the petitioner whereas AAG Amit Gupta for the UT, observed that appears from the record that the detenu has not moved a representation before the authority, therefore, this submission could not be considered. The Detaining Authority has observed that the detenu is continuously engaging in illicit trafficking in narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances which poses a serious threat to the health and welfare of the people

Through the medium of this appeal cum notice, public in general and motorists/devotees in particular visiting Kali Mata Mandir Bagh-e Bahu Jammu and Kandoli Mata Nagrota during the celebration of Holy Navratra festival w.e.f 09.04.2024 to 17.04.2024 for paying obeisance, are advised to follow the particular route to reach the respective Temple to minimize the traffic pressure/chaos of the approaching routes.

- During the Navratra period, there will be one-way vehicular traffic movement towards the Bagh-e-Bahu Temple to keep the Bahu Fort Route free from obstructions.
- During Navratra period, no vehicle will be allowed to move towards Bagh-e Bahu via Bahu Fort Road
- P/S Bagh-e Bahu crossing will be diversion point and all vehicles(LMVs/PSVs) going towards Bahu-Fort shall be diverted from P/S Bagh-e-Bahu Crossing towards Qasim Nagar and from where the vehicles shall further be diverted towards Bye - Pass Road NHH and Forest Check and then towards Ka.i Mata Mandir".
- The devotees and motorists are advised to follow the one -way route strictly to keep the road free for movement of devotee vehicles without any obstacles.
- During Navratra days No Heavy vehicle (HNV) shall be allowed to enter from Bye-Pass Naka NHH (Sldhra road) towards Bagh-e-Bahu/Bahu-fort area.

However, the manufacturer/supplier are allowed for any technological innovation in the design of ERS without any compromise in quality of individual component of ERS which should be as per globally accepted international standards. Moreover, the inspection shall have to be carried out through the third party as per the guidelines and shall also be witnessed by the representative of JKPCDC, the expenditure incurred in this behalf shall be borne entirely by the manufacturer/supplier.
