

KATHUA: Deputy Commissioner Kathua, Dr Rakesh Minhas, chaired a meeting to deliberate and strategise arrangements for seamless celebration of the festivals of Navratra and Eid-ul-Fitr across the district. At the outset, the DC Kathua who is also District Election Officer impressed upon Tehsildars concerned to ensure that no religious sites shall be used for election campaigning by any contesting candidate or by any political party while MCC is in force. Different aspects of arrangements were discussed comprehensively, including security measures, provision of safe drinking water, uninterrupted power supply, medical aid services, sanitation, availability of fire safety measures, street lighting, cleanliness, and transport management across the district. Heads of different departments were given directives to ensure meticulous planning and execution in their respective areas of responsibility, with a particular focus on

cleanliness and security to mitigate any potential untoward incidents during the festive period. The Jal Shakti department was entrusted with ensuring a consistent supply of potable water, while the Power Development Department (PDD) was directed to ensure uninterrupted electricity supply throughout the festival duration.
