NSS SKUAST-J organises debate, painting competition on Water and Peace

JAMMU: To commemorate World Water Day, 2024, National Service Scheme (NSS), SKUAST-Jammu under the guidance of the Vice Chancellor SKUAST-J, Dr. B.N. Tripathi and Dean Students Welfare Prof. Sudhakar Dwivedi, a debate and painting competition was organised for NSS students of faculty of Agriculture, faculty of Horticulture and Forestry, faculty of Agricultural Engineering and Institute of Biotechnology.

Dean Faculty of Agriculture, Prof. Anil Kumar and Prof. Sushil Sharma were the Chief Guest and Guest of Honour respectively. The programme started with the address by Dr. Subhash C Kashyap, NSS Programme Coordinator of the university. He in his address called upon the students to understand their responsibilities towards the communities where they are working.

Prof. Anil Kumar threw light on the rich source of water in India and importance of conserving and efficient use of water in daily use and in Agriculture. He stressed upon the need to save every drop of water and minimising the spillage of polluted water into rivers and other water bodies.

He called upon the NSS students to play a role in water body conservation and gave examples of maintenance of water bodies by our ancestors as sacred ponds and many localities are developed in their names. He stressed upon the students to make public aware that desilting of such ponds be done regularly. Dr. Sushil Sharma Dean FoAE elaborated the water conservation practices and concept of 'one drop more crop'. He also discussed about the role of water in crop production. He said scientists have developed soilless techniques of growing crops but till date there is no information or example of waterless crop production, hence, water is a precious commodity.

On the outset Prof. Sudhakar Dwivedi threw light on the importance of organising such events and said that NSS students can play a crucial role in making society aware about the value of water.

He also called upon the students to convey the message of judicious use of water in daily life. Students participated in debate competition on the topic Water for Peace, in which students expressed their views. Students also took part in painting cum drawing competition on the topic 'Importance of water' conveyed their message through beautiful painting. The vote of thanks was presented by Dr. Sushmita Dadich. 









