I, Mumtaz Ahmad-IPS, Commandant IRP- 12th BN call upon Constable Nayeem Manzoor Dar No. 481 (AWT (Now 309/IRP 12th) P1D No. EXK126056 S/O Manzoor Ahmad Dar R/O Maisuma Srinagar A/P Alamdar Colony Gopalpora Chadoora District Budgam on the following grounds:-

- Whereas, you have been transferred from Kashmir Zone (PD Awantipora) to Armed Zone vide PHQ J&K order No. 1793 of 2024 dated 10.07.2024 and further adjusted in this unit vide APHQ J&K order No. 604 of 2024 dated 02.08.2024 and stands relieved from APHQ J&K w.e.f. 02.02.2024 to report in this unit for further duties.
- Whereas, you were supposed to report in this unit after availing the journey time but you did not bother to report in this unit so far.
- Whereas, you were informed through Police Station Chadoora/PP Mochwa several times to report back on duty but you neither reported back nor any intimation regarding your whereabouts received from your end.
- Whereas, despite repeated messages you did not bother to resume your duties and opted to remain continuous absent from legitimate duties.
- Whereas, you were also served with Attendance Notice and Show Cause Notice I & II through a special messenger who handed over the same to you in presence of witnesses and you were informed to resume your duties. But till date you did not bother to report back for duties. It seems that you are not interested to serve more in the department.

Applications are invited from residents of Union Territory of J&K who own buildings in Udhampur near the vicinity of makeshift building of Govt. Medical College & Associated Hospital Udhampur (earlier erstwhile Distt. Hospital Udhampur) for hostel accommodation of MBBS 50-75Boys and 50-75 Girls (Separate buildings for boys and girls).

Terms and conditions:

- Two separate buildings will be used for accommodation of students 50-75Boys and 50-75 Girls near the vicinity of makeshift building of Govt. Medical College & Associated Hospital Udhampur till the permanent building of hostel at Village Bailis ready for shifting purpose or till it is required by Principal Govt. Medical College Udhampur Hostel purpose of GMC students purely on temporary basis initially for a period of six months on monthly rent basis, may be extended to one year on same terms and conditions Further also.
- The accommodation space shall be in an area authorized by local authority for opening such lease. The owner would be required to obtain the necessary approvals, if any, from the local authorities under rule for opening such lease.
- The accommodation space shall have adequate water and power supply provisions and the water bills and electricity bills will be cleared by the institution on actual basis as per the reading of the meter. Further the Service provider/ Building owner must provide document of Sanctioned Electricity load.
- Regular and Potable drinking water and electricity should be available and necessary and it is the sole responsibility of the owner to provide the portable drinking water to the MBBS students for drinking and other purposes.
- Buildings should be ready for accommodation in all aspects.
- Buildings should accommodate maximum of 2-3 students in each room and if possible attached washroom should be there in building.
- Buildings should have big common hall for student mess and space for running the kitchen of the students of around 20 x 20 sq. ft.
- Size of each room shall not be less than 15 x 15 sq. ft.
- Each hostel shall have a visitor room and a separate room for the Security Supervisor/ Guard.
- Rent assessment will be decided by District Rent assessment committee once the buildings are completed in every respect for shifting purposes and handover to college authorities for the execution of rent deed.
- The hostel building should be free from all encumbrances, claims and legal disputes.

Interested owners of the buildings should submit the applications agreed with the terms and conditions to the office of the Principal GMC Udhampur in person within 15 days of issuance of this notice.

Whereas, the Higher Education Department vide Government Order No.88-JK (HE) of 2024 dated 22-02-2024 issued appointment orders in favour of Mr. Mohit Sasan S/o Satish Kumar R/o Muradpur Tehsil and District Rajouri under PSP Category after getting satisfactory report from CID, with the directions to report to the Nodal Principal, Jammu within a period of 21 days from the date of issuance of the order, failing which the appointment shall be deemed to have cancelled without any further notice; and

Whereas, subsequently vide Government Order No. 182-JK (HE) of 2024 dated 13-03-2024 issued by the Higher Education Department, Mr. Mohit Sasan S/o Satish Kumar R/o Muradpur Tehsil and District Rajouri was posted in the Government Degree College, Rajouri; and

Whereas, the Nodal Principal, Jammu vide his office letter dated 29.05.2024 has intimated that Mr. Mohit Sasan, S/o Sh. Satish Kumar appointed as Assistant Professor in Commerce in Higher Education Department has joined in the office on 26-02-2024, and has attended the Office w.e.f. 26-02-2024 to 13-03-2024 and thereafter stopped attending the office without any leave or intimation and had not joined the office till date; and

Whereas, the Department vide letter dated 26-07-2024 requested the Nodal Principal, Jammu to intimate whereabouts of Mr. Mohit Sasan, newly appointed Assistant Professor (Commerce); and

Whereas, in response, the Nodal Principal, Jammu forwarded an Email dated 27-07-2024 wherein Mr. Mohit Sasan S/o Sh. Satish Kumar who was appointed as Assistant Professor (Commerce) has intimated about his unwillingness to join the service as Assistant Professor (Commerce) as he has been pursuing the Ph.D. in Commerce from University of Jammu in regular mode and is also preparing for Civil Services; and

Whereas, in view of above, a Notice dated 26.11.2024 was served to Mr. Mohit Sasan, Assistant Professor (Commerce) for resuming his duties in the office of Nodal Principal, Jammu within a period of seven (7) days. However, no reply/response was received from Mr. Mohit Sasan, which has necessitated issuance of the orders regarding the cancellation of his appointment made as Assistant Professor (Commerce) in the Department.
