# Shiv Sena released poster "Fearlessly visit Baba Barfani"

JAMMU : Shiv Sena (UBT) Jammu-Kashmir unit has issued a poster with the message "Fearlessly visit Baba Barfani" and appealed to devotees of Bholenath to take part in the Amarnath yatra and give a befitting reply to terrorism.

Along with this, a warning has been issued to terrorist organizations to face dire consequences if they dare to carry out any untoward incident.

In a press conference held today at the party's state central office, state chief Manish Sahni said that the purpose of the cowardly attack on Hindus in Pahalgam is to affect the Shri Amarnath yatra and create fear among Hindus. Sahni has issued a warning to the terrorist organizations that they will have to face serious consequences if they make any nefarious attempt to carry out any untoward incident

during the pilgrimage.

Along with this, Sahni said that to encourage the devotees of Baba Barfani, a group of Shiv Sainiks of revered Bala Sahab Thackeray will be present at the main base camps Pahalgam and Baltal during the yatra.

Sahni has released a poster "We will have darshan of Baba Barfani without fear" and appealed to people to participate in the yatra and take blessings of Bhole Baba. General Secretary Vikas

Bakshi, Senior Vice President Balwant Singh, Sanjeev Kohli were present on this occasion.

Manish Sahni praised the local Muslim youth Syed Adil Hussain Shah present at the Pahalgam attack site, who lost his life while trying to snatch the gun from the terrorist and save the Hindus, and others who saved the lives of people by lifting them on their shoulders and keeping them away from the reach of the terrorists' bullets, for

which a unique example of mutual brotherhood, Kashmir and humanity has been set, which is commendable. This is a slap on the face of those who create an atmosphere of terror and divide Hindus and Muslims, including Pakistan.

Manish Sahni, while expressing deep concern over the increasing terrorist incidents in Jammu and Kashmir, has demanded to increase the deployment of the army, bring the Jammu

and Kashmir Police Force under the state government and appoint an experienced and senior former army or police officer who has served in the state as the Lieutenant Governor of Jammu and Kashmir.

Sahni said that the Chief Minister of Jammu and Kashmir has organized an all-party meet in Kashmir today regarding the terrorist attack in Pahalgam, in which he was also invited to participate.

But due to some reason, he could not be a part of this meeting. Sahni demanded to raise his voice in unity in the all-party meet for the immediate restoration of full statehood and bring the Jammu and Kashmir Police Force under the people's elected state government.

Along with this, he reiterated the demand to appoint an experienced former senior army or police officer as the Lieutenant Governor.
