JAMMU: Eminent Physical Educationist, Rajesh Dhar, Lecturer in Physical Education delivered an impressive 'guest lecture' on the topic 'Role of Sports Psychology in Physical Education and Sports' to the officials (PPETs/PEMs) drawn from the Department of Youth Services and Sports, who are attending Refresher/Orientation Course in various sports disciplines at MA Stadium, here.

The 10-day long Course in which around 80 officials (PETS and PEMs) drawn from various districts of the Union Territory are taking part, is being organised by the Department of Youth Services and Sports, J&K.

Terming the Physical Education Teachers as the masters of all trades, Dhar advised them to gain the knowledge of Sports Psychology for acheiving perfection as trainers and coaches.

Quoting the example of Sachin Tendulkar and Vinod Kambli, Dhar said to blossom at the higher or highest level, more than possessing skill and talent one needed to be mentally tough, adding that both Sachin and Kambli were almost equally poised as far as talent and skill was concerned but there was hell of difference between the two at the highest

He said the knowledge of Sports Psychology, apart from other things can help Physical Education Teachers to go into the philosophy of the psyche of the players and choose good

team leaders. "As coaches and trainers you should focus on physical skills, strategy, and tactics, while sports psychology will help you to develop athletes mental resilience, motivation, and focus,. Every trainer or coach needs to develop good communication

skill and maintain good body language" Dhar maintained. Meanwhile, the sports disciplines in which the officials are being trained include Taekwondo, Fencing, Softball and Soft Tennis.

The Department has named 13 trained officials as the Resource Persons in the Course and they include Atul Pangotra (Course Incharge), Brinder Singh, Mukta Gupta and Rsjinder Singh (all Taekwondo); Ujjawal Gupta (Course Incharge), Razia Sultan and Abdul Qadir (all Fencing); Varinder Singh (Course Incharge), Madan Mohan and Usmat Shaban (Softball) and Ab Rehman Khan & Vishal Malhotra

(Course Incharges) and Shivali Rajput (all Soft Tennis). "The concept of "infusing perfection" among teachers is complex and can be approached in a way that focuses on excellence and continuous improvement rather than striving for unattainable flawlessness. Instead of aiming for perfection, teachers can focus on developing essential skills and qualities that contribute to effective teaching and student learning," said Rajinder Singh Tara, Director General Youth Services and Sports in a message.

JAMMU: The Relief and Rehabilitation Commissioner (M) J&K Dr. Arvind Karwani Saturday chaired a meeting to review the ongoing devel-

At the outset, Dr. Karwani emphasised the importance of adhering to the directions issued by the General Administration Department, wherein responsibilities of Transit Migrant Camps at Jammu and Kashmir have been assigned to various Government Departments Works(R&B) Jal Shakti Power Development Department, & Urban Development Department, Youth Sports, Department of Floriculture, Environmental Engineering Department (UEED), Development (JAKEDA) and Department of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj.

It has further been ordered

that the concerned departments shall nominate an officer, not below the rank of Executive Engineer for liaising /coordinating the execution/maintenance works/projects pertaining to their department with the Relief Organization (M), J&K.

After detailed deliberations in the meeting, the Jammu Municipal Corporation was asked to examine the demand for additional requirement of manpower to further improve day to day sanitation facility viz. collection, transportation and disposal of garbage and refuse in the migrant camps at Jagti, Nagrota, Muthi-Buta Nagar and Purkhoo.

The Department of Youth Services & Sports was asked to prepare a proposal for the maintenance of open spaces/ playgrounds, organize physical education activities and also promote Scouts and Guides activities in the migrant camps.

Department Floriculture was asked to develop open spaces and undertake maintenance of existing parks and implement various centrally sponsored schemes.

The UEED was asked to examine the requirement of planning, designing and construction of works of sewerage and drainage in the migrant camps and deal with issues of public health, to protect the inhabitants of migrant camps from the adverse environmental fac-

The JAKEDA was asked to explore installation and maintenance of solar lights and promotion/implementation of schemes of the Ministry of New Renewable Energy (MNRE), Government of India in the migrant camps.

The Department of Rural Development Panchayati Raj was asked to promote skill development programmes to enhance employability and support rural entrepreneurship.

The Executive Engineer PW(R&B)Department, apprised about the progress of works going on in the Migrant  $\operatorname{Camp}$ Jagti. Migrant Camp Nagrota, Migrant Camp Muthi - Buta Nagar and Migrant Camp Purkhoo. He was directed to expedite the completion of repair and renovation works regarding which approval stands accorded.
