

Comm Secy GAD discusses modalities regarding district Capex Budget for Kathua

KATHUA: Commissioner Secretary, General Administration Department, Manoj Kumar Dwivedi, who is also Incharge Secretary for development works of Kathua district, held a meeting of district Capex Budget for 2021-22.

District Development Commissioner; Rahul Yadav, presented physical and financial achievements registered under district Capex budget during 2020-21 through detailed power point presentation.

While presenting the sector wise performance under last Capex budget, DDC informed the meeting that the district has achieved 100 per cent expenditure of the available allocated funds under schemes like NRLM and PMAY besides achieving 99 per cent achievement under MGNREGA of Rural Development Department.

DDC also presented scheme wise financial achievement under district Capex Budget 2020-21 informing that the district has expended over 92 per cent of the total allocation for development schemes of various sectors like Jal Shakti, Transport, Social Services, Youth Services and Sports, Urban Development, PHE, ICDS/ Nutrition, Mid Day Meal etc.

Commissioner Secretary, while discussing different plan components, said that with the functioning of three-tier Panchayati Raj system

the development priority has to be set by the elected PRI representatives through a laid down procedure. He said planning must be done to make tangible assets benefitting larger portion of the community. He also called for taking up convergence to achieve multi dimensional development targets.

While laying thrust on taking development spree at all levels, Commissioner Secretary said the development and Corona control measures will go side by side and every endeavor shall be

made for strict adherence to Covid guidelines while undertaking development works.

He underscored the importance of covering all uncovered habitations while formulating Jal Jeevan Mission so that benefit reach to the last beneficiary. He also called for prioritizing drinking water connectivity to Girls Schools and Aanganwadi centres while making micro planning of Jal Jeevan Mission.

He directed the DDC to take periodic review of the planning status and ensure removal of existing flaws in execution of development schemes by personally visiting the sites. He asked him to focus on resolving issues being confronted in smooth execution of PHE and Irrigation related schemes.

To achieve 100% saturation under key Centrally Sponsored Schemes, Manoj Kumar Dwivedi directed the DDC to ensure timely approval of plan with special focus on sector that witnessed

less expenditure during last fiscal.

DDC apprised that committees are being constituted under the chairmanship of Nodal Officers of different departments to process sector wise planning involving all stakeholders.

Manoj Kumar Dwivedi also called upon the concerned officers to look upon the self employment sector and chalk out ways to reach out to maximum beneficiaries in this year's Capex budget. He asked CPO to micro-review the sector wise planning and keep department wise analysis on daily basis. He also held detailed discussion on tendering process of development works and effective mechanism for e-tendering of works to be taken up under Capex.

The meeting was attended by ADC Atul Gupta, CPO Uttam Singh, CMO, Dr Ashok Chaudhary, ACR Devinder Paul, ACD Narayan Dutt Sharma besides officers of line and works departments.

No procurement centre in Samba, Deptt lacks staff strength: Manjit

VIJAYPUR: Apni Party Provincial President and Former Minister Manjit Singh today appealed to the Agriculture Dept. to strengthen its staff for procurement of agricultural produce of farmers in Samba District.

"The Agriculture Dept has failed to procure the agricultural produce from the farmers and hence, compelled them to sell the produce to the middle-men on lower cost," said Manjit Singh in a statement issued seeking review of the policy by the Govt to make it favourable for the farmers. He said that the Agriculture Dept. has

remained unable to procure all the produce of the farmers and middlemen take advantage of the situation causing financial losses to the farmers.

"The middlemen collect agriculture produce from the doorstep of the farmers even as they pay less than the rate set by the Govt. And on the other, the Govt has taken no concrete steps to increase staff members of the Dept nor do they have any plan to collect agriculture produce from the fields of the farmers in a bid to facilitate them," alleged the Former Minister.

He said that "The farmers are compelled to take their

produce from their village alongwith their produce and travel to the defined centres which are far away from their villages. And, then their produce is not procured with multiple excuses."

In directly, he said, the Dept. officials lack interest in procurement and compel farmers to sell their produce in less cost to the middlemen.

He appealed to Lt Governor Manoj Sinha to review the functioning of the Dept so that the procurement is channelized and officials responsible for ignoring procurement and harassment of farmers can be held accountable.
