## Designated partners of all LLPs in J&K must register immediately as Business Users

SRINAGAR: In a significant development, all the Designated Partners of Limited Liability Partnerships (LLPs) incorporated within the UT of J&K and Ladakh are being informed to mandatorily register themselves as 'Business Users' on the recently launched Version 3 of MCA21 System.

This decision was taken during a meeting held on Tuesday in the office of Registrar of Companies (ROC) for UTs of J&K and Ladakh.

Designated partner as a concept in LLP is similar to a Director in a company.

In this direction, the neces-

sary guidelines and instructions have already been passed on to Professional Institutes to sensitize all the stakeholders about this transition. All the designated partners of LLPs incorporated should complete this exercise in earliest possible time.

Meanwhile, the meeting in this regard at Jammu was chaired by Sudhir Phaye and by Haamid Bukhari in Kashmir.

It was given out that this is a nationwide exercise across all the ROC offices in the country and will ensure proper identification of Designated Partners (DPs) who have incorporated themselves in body corporate form of LLP.

## Sukhnandan raises issue of water channels to save farmers

JAMMU: Questioning the timing of releasing water from the river into channels, Sukhnandan Choudhary requested the J&K LG for an early inquiry on the negligence in clearing the water channels.

Sukhnandan Kumar, Chairman BJP Panchayati Raj Cell & former Minister, raised the issue of clearing the water channels to save the farmers while he was addressing media persons at BJP headquarter, Trikuta Nagar, here.

J&K BJP Kissan Morecha President Omi Khajuria DDC Member, Bishnah Dhaminder Kumar and Pt. Narayan Dutt Sharma (Bishnah) State Executive

Member BJP were also present in the press conference.

"How the water is released without the proper maintenance of the important concerned channels and the water routes are cleared?" said Sukhnandan Kumar while addressing the media persons at party headquarter.

He said that officials have opened up the canals at Baisakhi for the appraisal before J&K LG but they were opened without clearing them. He said that farmers are left hopeless with this inadequate arrangement.

He said that at present the hybrid varieties of Paddy

process and yet to be completed and hence the water from the river has nowhere to go.

He said that due to this major flaw, water channels

cannot work to their full capacity because of which the hard working farmers of the region are suffering badly.

on the Domala siphon on D17 Ranbir Canal near BSF

Pittel post is also in process and yet to be completed. He said that areas outside fencing

are at full loss and damage due to this fault in the supply system. He said that the estimate for the same has

been forwarded and taken up

many times but yet no

progress is visible on the ground level related to this issue.


He said that due to this water is not reaching the tail end Panchayats till borders like Nikkowal.

Sukhnandan also raised the issue of the lift irrigation schemes and stressed that the tube wells should be taken care of.

Sukhnandan requested the Lieutenant Governor of Jammu & Kashmir to take cognizance of these issues on the priority basis. He asked for an inquiry in the lapses that caused huge sufferings to the farmers.

JAMMU: An application seeking cancellation of bail moved by the then Sub Divisional Police Officer (SDPO) R.S. Pura on 09.09.2020 in case titled 'State through Police Station Arnia Vs. Bhanu Partap Singh' was dismissed by the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jammu.

The application was moved by the then SDPO R.S. Pura on the premise that accused in case FIR no. 32/2009 for offence under section 13 of ULA Act who was admitted to bail was summoned in connection with investigation for 06.07.2020. He, however, allegedly did not turn up resulting in institution of application for cancellation of bail granted to him."

The court also noted that one casual reference of non-appearance by accused before Investigating Agency is too flimsy a ground to cancel bail. With these observations, court rejected the application.
