

Dr Jitendra addresses Jammu Urban Bodies' representatives, emphasises municipal economic growth

NEW DELHI: Addressing the Workshop/ Programme on Urban Governance for Mayors/ Chairpersons and Municipal Commissioners/ Chief Executives Officers from Urban Local Bodies from Jammu & Kashmir, Union Minister, Dr Jitendra Singh, who is also Chairman Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), emphasised municipal economic growth and said that small and medium towns of the UT will play an important role to develop municipal infrastructure as enabler to economic activities particularly in the areas of processing agro-produce, weaving industry, and development of IT services.

Dr Jitendra said that transition from agriculture sector to manufacturing is particularly important for J&K which has taken up specific steps towards rapid economic growth and investments in the state economy, particularly during the last three years.


These steps will bring a shift in the economic profile of the state and create more jobs in manufacturing and services.

Dr Jitendra said, Prime Minister Modi has great plans for the development of J&K and accordingly, we have established urban local bodies as per 74th Constitution Amendment Act. He said, with elected bodies, application of urban missions of Government of India like the development of Infrastructure, improvement of quality of life, environment, mobility, water and sanitation will achieve full potential.

Dr Singh pointed out that the three day orientation programme will provide a suitable exposure on government missions, schemes and programmes.

Coming back to the J&K, Dr Jitendra Singh said, the UT has 27% urban population in 2011 and this poses a challenge to move towards half way mark of urbanisation which means more attention on industries and investment in coming decades. This journey process means acceleration of urban

sector reforms effectively for municipal services and infrastructure as initiated by our urban missions and underlined that the role of elected leaders of municipal bodies will be important to achieve this goal as these leaders constitute a pool of grass root leaders and promote a bottom up leadership in our federal structure of democracy. In his concluding remarks, Dr Jitendra said, the organisation of this course by IIPA in the 75th years of Independence has special significance in view of our plans for India@2047. He said, during the next 25 years India will undergo a transition from semi-urban (25% plus) to urban majority society and economic growth and urbanisation will go hand in hand. The Minister hoped that this three day visit on urban governance will provide live cases and agenda for each of our elected representatives and will add to our efforts to make the State a clean, green and productive city.

Public Notice

For Prohibition of Public nuisance in Public places in the Municipal Committee areas in Leh/Kargil

In Compliance to the;

1. Municipal Solid Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules 2016
2. Hazardous and other waster (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016
3. Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban & Rural) Guidelines, 2014
4. Guidelines issued by the government of India Ministries
5. Notifications issued by the UT, Ladakh and local government entities
6. Hon;ble National Green Tribunal Orders issued from time-to-time and;

To accomplish our mission to make ladakh one cleanest destinations in the world and to achieve the greater objective of Swachh Bharat Mission, The Municipal Committee of Leh/Kargil hereby notifies the following prohibition, with immediate effect, and these prohibitions shall remain in force until further notification

A. Prohibition of Littering

1. No person shall throw or deposit any litter such as carry bag, packets, wrappers, cigarette, butts, bio-medical wastes including face masks etc. in any occupied/ unoccupied/ open/ vacant/ public or vacant private land except in authorized public or private litter receptacles.
2. No person shall deposit/ throw such litter upon any street/ road/ sidewalk/ playground/ garden/ traffic island or other public/ private places from any vehicle either moving or parked.
3. All persons, including children are being advised to carry own bag/ container to keep the trash and dispose it only at designated places or at home wastebins.

If anyone found violating this Notification, Will be liable to pay penalty of INR 500 for each incidence of violation

B. Prohibition of Spitting:

1. No person shall spit any pan/ gutkha/ tobacco/ chewing gum etc. in any occupied/ unoccupied/ open/ vacant/ Public or open place.
- 2.No person shall spit any pan/ gutkha/ tobacco/ chewing gum etc, upon any street/ road/ side walk/ playground/ garden/ traffic island or other public/ private places from any vehicle either moving or parked.

If anyone found violating this Notification, will be liable to pay penalty of INR 500 for each incidence of violation.

C. Prohibition of open defecation:

1. No person, including children shall urinate/ bath/ defecate in any in any occupied/ unoccupied/ open/ vacant/ public or unoccupied open place except in such public facilities or convenience specifically provided for these purpose.

If anyone found violating this Notification, will be liable to pay penalty INR 500 for each incidence of violation.

D. Prohibition of washing/cleaning:

1. No person shall wash/ clean cloths, upholstery, utensils, vehicles in any public or open place including but not limited to riverside/ nullah/ waterbodies/ street road / side walk/ playground/ garden, traffic island etc.


If anyone found prohibiting this Notification, will be liable to pay penalty of INR 500 for each incidence of violation

E. Prohibition of burning of waste in open places:

There shall be complete prohibition on open burning of waste (including but not limited to plastic, poluthene, flex boards, thermocaul, rubber, tyres, cloths, agriculture wastes etc) in any occupied/ unoccupied/ open/ vacant/ public or unoccupied private place, including but not limited to riverside/ nullah, waterbodies/ street/ road side-walk/ playground/ garden etc.

Violators, any person or body responsible of such burning, shall be liable to pay environment compensation of Rs. 5,000 in case of simple burning while Rs 25, 000 in case of bulk waste burning.
