CRIME REPORT

HSRP checking drive: ARTO Reasi compounds scores of violators, recovers Rs 24,000 fine

REASI: Assistant Regional Transport Officer Reasi Rajesh Gupta on Tuesday conducted extensive checking on Katra-Jammu road to check HSRP plates and overloading by passenger vehicles. During checking, 250 vehicles were checked & 28 vehicles were Challenged for overloading & other violations, while 14 others were Challenged for not having HSRP. The violators were compounded and a fine of Rs 24,000 was recovered on the spot. The team also sensitized the drivers about relevant sections of Motor vehicle Act and urged them to affix HSRP plates on their vehicles besides keeping documents updated in all respects. They were further asked to follow traffic rules in letter and spirit to ensure their safety as well as safety of others.

Three misguided teenagers from Sopore rescued, handed-over to families

SOPORE: In a joint action, Jammu and Kashmir Police and Army have prevented three teenagers from falling into trap of terrorists by apprehending them from forest areas of village Kandi. The three misguided boys were on way to cross the Line of Control (LoC) in Kupwara.

The three teenagers identified as Nasir Ahmad Waza, son of Gh Rasool Waza, Adnan Naseer Khan, son of Naseer Ahmad Khan and Umar Reyaz Sofi, son of Reyaz Ahmad Sofi, all residents of Dooru Sopore were following a route which was explained to them by a surrendered terrorist of their locality. The teenagers were believed to have been motivated by stories of glamorisation of terrorists by a surrendered terrorist, who showed them the way to reach Pakistan. The joint operation of Police and Army was launched when an input regarding some suspicious movement in forest areas usually followed by terrorists was received by Police. On apprehension, the matter was investigated and it was found that the teenagers seem to have been misguided and should get a chance to lead a normal life.

4 bovines rescued; 3 smugglers arrested

SAMBA: Police on Tuesday foiled an attempt to smuggle bovines by rescuing 4 bovines with the arrest of 3 bovine smugglers at Ghagwal.

As per the details, acting on an information received from reliable source regarding smuggling of bovines by foot near village Randhwal, Ghagwal, a party of Police Station Ghagwal rushed to the area and rescued 4 bovines with the arrest of 03 persons namely Alam, son of Bika, Atar Din, son of Bika, both residents of both residents of Rakh Barotian, Samba and Billu, son of Musa, resident of Malani Tehsil Rajpura District Samba. FIR No. 75/2022 under section 188 IPC was registered against the arrested accused.

4 absconders arrested

JAMMU/KATHUA: Four absconders evading their arrests for a long time were arrested.

As per details, an information was received at Police Station Gangyal regarding an absconder evading arrest since 2016 i.e., 6 years in FIR No 04/2016 registered under sections 279/338 of IPC. On this, a team of Police Station Gangyal under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Gangyal Insp Joginder Singh Chib, after putting in strenuous efforts, arrested the absconder namely Nirmal Singh, son of Raghubir Singh, resident of Janyal Tehsil and District

Pathankot (PB). He will be produced before the 1st Additional Munsiff Forest JMJC Jammu for further proceedings.

Similarly, information regarding an absconder who was evading his arrest since 2015 i.e., 7 years in FIR No. 15/2015 registered under sections 279/304 of RPC was received at Police Station Akhnoor. On this, a team of Police Station Akhnoor under supervision of SDPO Akhnoor Varun Jandial led by SHO Akhnoor Inspr Hilal Azhar assisted by Incharge Border Police Post Garkhal ASI Rajinder Singh Parihar, arrested absconder namely Ramji Das, son of Sansar Chand, resident of Gurha Brahmana, Akhnoor. Now, he will be produced before the Court of JMJC Akhnoor for further legal proceedings.

Another information regarding an absconder, who was evading arrest since 2009 i.e., 13 years in FIR 81/2009 registered under section 188 of RPC was received at Police Station Bahu Fort. On this, a team from Police Station Bahu Fort under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Jaffrey led by SHO Bahu Fort Inspr Nayat Ali assisted by PSI Farmeen Choudhary, after putting in strenuous efforts, arrested the absconder namely Ab Rashid, son of Mureed Baksh, resident of Manhor Gopala, Samba.

Meanwhile, Kathua police under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal also arrested an absconder evading arrest since 2020, as he was wanted in FIR No. 38/2020 registered under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act at Police Station Billawar. On specific information, a police team led by PSI Ravinder Singh Incharge Police Post Ramkot under close supervision of SDPO Billawar Arvind Kumar in coordination with Anantnag Police nabbed accused namely Anzar Hussain, son of Riyaz Ahmed, resident of Brariangham Tehsil Shangus District Anantnag and further investigation started.

5 fresh COVID cases in J&K

SRINAGAR: Jammu and Kashmir on Tuesday recorded five fresh COVID-19 cases that took its tally to 4,54,153, officials said.

The death toll remained unchanged at 4,752.

Of the fresh cases, three were reported from Jammu district and two from Srinagar district, the officials said. The number of active COVID-19 cases in the union territory stands at 50. So far, 4,49,351 people have recovered from the viral disease, they said.
