In a press statement issued here, Kundan Kashmiri said that no doubt UT administration has directed concerned authorities to resolve all service-related matters of PM package employees besides posting them at district Headquarters and not in remote areas. "This shows that administration is contemplating to give a final shape of resolve all issues of PM package employees, but these simple measures will not give ensure safety of KPs as Rahul Bhat was also posted in a safe area and still he was martyred. The gun-yielded youth left the spot freely and easily without any check.

Same thing at happened at wine shop in Baramulla," said Kundan, adding, "Government needs to contain these divisive elements effectively and has to come up with a foolproof security strategy to ensure safety of minority Hindu community in Valley. Till that time, KP employees should be posted outside valley."
