# CRIME REPORT

## Five theft cases solved; juvenile among 3 arrested, stolen gold ornaments & other items recovered

**JAMMU/R S PURA:** Police on Saturday solved five theft cases by arresting 2 accused persons while a juvenile was nabbed and recovered stolen gold ornaments & items.

As per the details, a complain was logged at Police Post Chowk Chabutra by one person namely Rahul Gupta, son of Bushan Lal Gupta, resident of Jain Bazar (Baba Lal Ji Chowk) in the jurisdiction of Police Station Pacea Danga. On this, FIR No. 61/2022 under section 379/IPC was registered at Police Station Pacea Danga.

After this, a team of Police Post Chowk Chabutra under the supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kalu led by SHO Pacea Danga Insp. Raghubir Singh assisted by In-Charge Police Post Chowk Chabutra PSI Jyoti Choudary did strenuous efforts and police teams finally arrested one Juvenile suspect and after further questioning. He confessed his involvement in the above case and on his disclosure, 11 bicycles were recovered from his possession i.e 07 simple bicycle and 04 gear bicycles. The accused got arrested on the spot.

Meanwhile, R S Pura Police also solved four theft cases by arresting two thieves and recovered 11.5 grams of stolen gold ornaments along with other items.

Several complaints were lodged at PS RS Pura regarding theft cases in the area such as theft of 6 grams of gold ornaments in one case, 5.5 grams of gold ornaments in another case and similarly theft of 14 steel frames of doors and one hand pump motor, one drum etc in different cases. Four different cases i.e case FIR No 74, 75, 95 & 91/2022 under section 454/380 IPC were registered at Police Station RS Pura and investigation started.

After this, team of Police Station RS Pura under the supervision of SDPO RS Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO RS Pura Insp. Rajesh Sharma did strenuous efforts and with the help of various inputs and CCTV footages of the area finally rounded up two different suspects namely Sohan Lal alias Sonu, son of Tarsen Lal, resident of Chakrohi and Amit Kumar, son of Hans Raj, resident of Banota RS Pura. During sustained questioning accused confessed their involvement in the above cases i.e accused namely Sohan Lal confessed his involvement in case FIR No 74/2022 under section 454/380 IPC, Case FIR No 95/2022 under section 454/380 IPC, case FIR No 75/2022 under section 454/380 IPC and accused namely Amit Kumar involved in case FIR No 91/22 under section 454/380 IPC. Both were arrested and on their disclosure all the 11.5 grams of stolen gold items and other items were recovered from their possession.

The overall arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SP Hqrs Rannish Gupta.

## 117 bovines rescued; 7 smugglers arrested

**UDHAMPUR:** In its continued efforts to eradicate the menace of bovine smuggling from the society, Udhampur Police under the overall supervision of SSP Udhampur Dr. Vinod Kumar rescued 117 bovines and arrested 7 smugglers in the Jurisdiction of Police Post Tikri.

As per the details, a team led by In-Charge Police Post Tikri PSI Abdul Satar under the supervision of DySP Hqrs. Udhampur Sahil Mahajan during routine naka/checking duty in its jurisdictional area noticed few persons enrouted from Tikri towards Kashmir Valley side in connection with smuggling of bovines. On thorough checking 117 bovines were found which were being taken by foot without any legal permission. Thereafter, all the 117 bovines were rescued and 7 bovine smugglers namely Hassan Mir, son of Mohd. Mirza, resident of R.S Pura; Mushtaq Ahmed, son of Mohd. Iqbal, resident of Jammu; Manzoor Ahmed, son of Raji Mohd,

resident of Bishnah, Jammu; Sadiq Hussain, son of Mohd. Gali, resident of R.S Pura; Farid Hussain, son of Qasim Din, resident of R.S Pura; Farooq Ali, son of Qasim Din, resident of Samba and Abdul Rashid, son of Mohd. Yousuf, resident of Ramban were arrested on spot.

In this regards, Case FIR Nos 112,113,114, 115, 116, 117, 118/2022 under relevant sections of law were registered in Police Station Rehambal and further investigation is going on.

## 80 vehicles Challenged, 18 seized for various MVA violations

## Minor raped; accused arrested

**REASI:** Police on Saturday arrested an accused for raping a minor girl in Reasi.

As per the details, one person name withheld of Charalakote Tehsil Bhomag District Reasi lodged a written complaint on 5th of May 2022 that her minor daughter of 17 year age (name withheld) was raped by someone. On getting this information, FIR No 109/2022 under section 376/341 IPC was lodged at Police Station Reasi investigation started.

Team of Police Station Reasi and Police Post Totesari started finding clues of the rapist, enquired about him from family, neighbors and family friends.

Amit Gupta Senior Superintendent of Police Reasi constituted a special team. Police team remained on chasing the accused constantly and finally arrested the accused Ganesh Singh S/O Kartar Singh R/O Chourakote Tehsil Bhomag district Reasi.

SSP Reasi conveyed that the case will be investigated thoroughly to minutest of details & chargesheet against the accused will be produced in the court of law with stipulated time.

Reasi Police is being regularly briefed to remain sensitive towards crime against women especially minors further appealed that girls should remain aware of such type of fraudsters who remain on the mission of spoiling the life of innocents.



## Drug peddler nabbed with approx. 25 Kgs poppy straw

**KATHUA:** Kathua Police while continuing its 'War on Drugs' putting concrete efforts to eradicate the drugs menace from the society and in consequence, District Police Kathua on Saturday recovered approx. 25 Kilograms of poppy straw (Phukki) like narcotics near Londi Morh Naka point and arrested a drug peddler besides seized the vehicle. As per the details, on the overall directions of SSP Kathua, R.C Kotwal, a police team led by Insp Sunil Kumar SHO Hiranagar under the supervision of SDPO Border Pankaj Soodan during Naka checking duty at Londi Morh noticed one suspicious Truck (HP72C-5557) which was being driven by a person namely Liyaqat Ali, son of Bashir Ahmed, resident of Bandhore Tehsil Marheen who was enrouted from Samba side towards Kathua was signalled to stop for checking. On thorough checking, approximately 25 kilograms of Poppy straw like narcotics was recovered from his possession. The accused was arrested and FIR No. 67/2022 under section 8/15/ NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Hiranagar.
