

## Langer reviews functioning of Directorate of Economics, Statistics

JAMMU: Secretary, Planning Development and Monitoring Department, Dr Raghav Langer, on Sunday conducted a detailed inspection and review of functioning of Directorate of Economics and Statistics.

Director General, DES, Satveer Kour and other senior officials were present in the meeting. Secretary visited the Statistical Training Institute imparting different kinds of training to the trainees. He took round of various sections of the directorate including offices of various Joint and Deputy Directors to assess working conditions for the staff.

Secretary also chaired a meeting with the officers of DES to have an overview of complete working of the

department. During the meeting, Director General highlighted the mission, functions and organizational setup of DES. She informed that the Directorate is responsible for collection, interpretation of statistical data in the UT for overall planning, conducting periodic surveys and censuses, NSSO surveys, economic survey, evaluation and impact assessment studies, 100 per cent physical verification of works under CAPEX budget, preparation of UT's income estimates, capital formation, collection of vital statistics on births and deaths, collection of data for annual price Index, annual survey of industries, price collection of essential commodities for calculating CPI/WPI, generating data for preparing figures of per capita income

and GSDP. Secretary lauded the efforts of the Directorate & District Statistics & Evaluation Officers (DSEOs) for playing a pivotal role in preparing for the first time the District Good Governance Index (DGGI) for the UT in collaboration with J&K IMPARD and DARPG last year. DG also apprised regarding the issues pertaining to cadre review, pending DPC cases and training requirements in latest IT tools for capacity building of human resource. Secretary stressed upon the officers to make the data of surveys and evaluation studies available to all the stakeholder departments and public in a simplified and user friendly format.

In such circumstances JKBoSE is not in a position to conduct the aforesaid examination.

It is, as such, once again impressed upon all the D.EI.Ed Institutions affiliated with JKBoSE to start the Class-work through Offline Mode w.e.f 23-05-2022 positively, under an intimation to this office, for a period of three months, enabling the candidates to become eligible to appear in the aforesaid examination.

It may be noted that any laxity noticed in this regard, the concerned Promoter of the D.EI.Ed Institute shall be personally responsible for delay in conduct of 2 year D.EI.Ed examination 2019-21 and Board shall not incur any responsibility on this score.

### Interim Advisory of Monkeypox

• It is a viral zoonotic disease, usually self-limited, occurs primarily in tropical rainforest areas of Central and West Africa, occasionally exported to other regions.

• **Symptoms: Fever, Rash and Swollen Lymph Nodes.**

• **Transmitted from Animal to Humans**


• **Limited Human to Human transmission.**

• **Incubation period ranges between 7-14 days**

**Current Scenario:** As on date (20th May 2022) cases of Monkeypox have been reported from U.K, U.S.A, Europe, Australia and Canada with no death.

**Indian context:** It has not been reported in India, but with new cases being detected from various countries chances of this disease occurring in India cannot be ruled out.

Cases that have been reported worldwide are both due to local transmission and travel to African countries.



Sites of Clinical Manifestations of Monkeypox Complication

NCDC, MoHFW has identified following public health actions to be initiated in event of suspected cases.

#### Recommended Public health actions

1. **Heightened suspicion in people with:**
  - a) An otherwise unexplained rash &
  - b) History of Travel, in the last 21 days, to a country with confirmed /suspected cases of monkeypox
  - c) contact with a person/people with confirmed/ suspected monkey pox.
2. All suspected cases to be isolated at designated healthcare facilities until all lesions have resolved and a fresh layer of skin has formed.
 

or

Until the treating physician decides to end isolation.
3. All such patients to be reported to the District Surveillance Officer of Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme.
4. All infection control practices to be followed.
