SRINAGAR: Advisor to Lieutenant Governor, Rajeev Rai Bhatnagar on Monday remarked that NEP-2020 has created a suitable platform in universities and other educational institutions for translation of research, ideas and innovations into actions for betterment of society.

BANDIPORA: The Deputy Commissioner (DC) Bandipora, Dr. Owais Ahmed on Monday took stock of the arrangements being put in place at Sumbal Transit Camp by various line departments for SANJY-2022.

At the outset, the DC sought details from the concerned regarding the facilities available including accommodation, water, electricity, arrangements for food and medical facilities besides other essentials.

He stressed for intensified preparations for the basic amenities at the transit camp and directed concerned officers to take all yatra related works on priority.

The meeting was attended by District Programme Officer ICDS Mohd Ashraf Hakaak, Sub Divisional Magistrate Sumbal Dr. Bashir Ahmad Lone, Joint Director Planning Imtiyaz Ahmad, officers from PHE, R&B and other senior officers of the district.


