Special Judge CBI Cases Jammu R K Wattal after hearing M M Sharma Senior PP and V K Dogra PP for CBI, observed that accused were caught red handed while accepting the bribe, which establishes prima facie presumption of involvement in offence under Section 7 of PC ACT 1988.

"Consideration of likelihood of hampering of the investigation and tampering of evidence by the accused whose statements have not been recorded as yet, the fact that investigation is still at earliest stage the societal interest at large is definitely not going to be served if the individual right of the accused to bail is given preference at this stage," the Court observed and dismissed the bail applications.

contacts with his handlers and after every communication he used to destroy the SIM card, he said. "Accused Junaid was engaged in recruiting members for the outlawed LeT terrorist outfit. They had been tasked to misguide, brainwash and create anti-national feelings among selected youth and recruit them as member for the LeT. "He used five SIM cards to create five Facebook accounts through which he used to share anti-national posts. He would contact radicalised youth to join the LeT, thereby promoting communal enmity and wage war against the State," an ATS statement said.

On receiving specific information, the Kalachowky (Mumbai) unit of the ATS had started a probe against four persons in connection with a case related to alleged recruitment of new members for the Pakistan-headquartered terror outfit and sending them to Jammu and Kashmir for training in subversive activities, the official said. One of these suspects was identified as Junaid Mohammed following which an FIR under IPC sections 121A (conspiracy to commit offences), 153A (promoting enmity between different groups), 116 (abetment of an offence) and also the IT Act was registered and he was apprehended by an ATS team led by Police Inspector Manjusha Bhosle, he said. Junaid Mohammed allegedly came in contact with active LeT members through a social media group named 'Ansar Gazwat UI Hind', the official said. The three other accused wanted in the case are still absconding, he said, adding further probe was on. Defence lawyer Yashpal Purohit said in Pune, "The ATS sought custody of Junaid Mohammed on various grounds, including that he was in touch with the LeT, was trying to recruit members for the outfit and also try-

ing to procure arms for the LeT. The ATS claimed he had done reece of some places. On this basis, his ATS custody was granted till June 3."

Asked about Junaid Mohammed getting funds, Purohit said, "As per the remand report, with funds, he was supposed to get arms and recruit more people. He has travelled to Kashmir several times, but the purpose of these trips was unknown and that is why custody has been given. He has been brained washed by LeT recruiters. He was shown videos and pictures to get him into the organisation."

statement. Terrorists of Pakistan-based outfits Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT) and Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) had carried out the 26/11 Mumbai terror attack and the January 2016 Pathankot airbase attack.

JuD, led by Hafiz Saeed, is the front organisation for the LeT which is responsible for carrying out the 2008 Mumbai attack that killed 166 people, including six Americans.

Saeed, a Pakistani national, is a UN-designated terrorist on whom the US has placed a USD 10 million bounty.

Last month, the Indian government designated as a terrorist Ali Kashif Jan, the Pakistani handler of the 2016 terror attack on Pathankot air base in which six terrorists and seven Indian soldiers were killed.

India has been asking Pakistan to take credible, verifiable and irreversible actions against terrorist networks and proxies operating from its soil and bring the perpetrators of the 26/11 Mumbai and Pathankot attack to justice.

In their joint statement, the Quad leaders also reaffirmed the UNSC Resolution 2593 (2021), which demands that the Afghan territory must never again be used to threaten or attack any country or to shelter or train terrorists, or to plan or finance terrorist attacks. We emphasise the importance of upholding international standards on anti-money laundering and combating the financing of terrorism by all countries, consistent with FATF recommendations.

We reaffirm that in our fight against global terrorism, we will take concerted action against all terrorist groups, including those individuals and entities designated pursuant to the UNSC Resolution 1267(1999), it said. The Financial Action Task Force (FATF) is an inter-governmental body established in 1989 to combat money laundering, terrorist financing and other related threats to the integrity of the international financial system. The Paris-based FATF has placed Pakistan on its grey list since June 2018 for failing to check money laundering, leading to terrorist financing, and was given a plan of action to complete it by October 2019.

Since then, Pakistan continues to be on the FATF's list due to its failure to comply with the FATF mandates.

J&K SSB registers...

It was informed that among all recruiting agencies, the Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board has recruited the highest number of candidates for various departmental posts through a transparent recruitment process. The figure for the financial year 2021-22 stands at 9,390.

Cumulatively, during 2021-22, a total of 11,434 recruitments were made including 9,390, 561, and 1,483 selections by J&K Service Selection Board, J&K Public Service Commission, and J&K Bank, respectively.

Gyanvapi mosque dispute: Fresh plea in SC seeks intervention in proceedings

NEW DELHI: A fresh plea has been filed in the Supreme Court seeking intervention in the Gyanvapi mosque dispute. It contended that Muslims cannot assert any right in respect of any piece of land claiming to be mosque unless it has been constructed on legally owned and occupied virgin land.

The petitioner stated that property vested in deity continues to be the deity's property irrespective of the fact that any person has taken illegal possession and offering namaz.

The petition, filed by advocate Ashwini Kumar Upadhyay through advo-

cate Ashwani Kumar Dubey, submitted that only those places can be protected, which were erected or constructed in accordance with personal law of the person erected/constructed them, but places erected or constructed in derogation of the personal law, cannot be termed as a 'place of worship'.

"It is submitted that retrospective cutoff-date was fixed August 15, 1947 to legalise the illegal acts of barbaric invaders. Though, Hindu Law (Temple Character never changes) was 'Law in force' at the commencement of the Constitution by virtue of Article 372(1).

"It is submitted that

Hindus, Jains, Buddhists, Sikhs have right to profess, practice propagate religion as provided in their religious scriptures and Article 13 prohibits from making law which takes away their rights," the plea said.

The petition contended that the status of mosque can be given only to such structures which have been constructed according to tenets of Islam and mosques constructed against the provisions contained in Islamic law cannot be termed as mosque.

Anjuman Intezamia Masjid, the management committee of the Gyanvapi mosque, had moved the apex court seeking stay on the survey of the complex.
