Prosecution's failure leads to acquittal in murder of cop

SRINAGAR: 1st Additional Sessions Judge Srinagar Ajay K Gupta while dismissing a Challan in murder case of a cop, observed that the prosecution didn't succeed in proving its case beyond all reasonable doubts and benefit of doubt has to go to all accused persons.

As per the facts of case, on October 14, 2011 a written docket was sent by the prosecution witness No.1 to Police station, Hazratbal, wherein it was stated that he along with prosecution witnesses Nos 3 to 7 and other police personnel were deputed at Tailbal Adda, Hazratbal for Friday prayers. After completion of prayers there was a huge rush of people. In the meantime, in order to cause harassment and terror among people some unknown terrorists with an automatic weapon, which he had obtained illegally and with an intention of callable homicide fired upon a constable Sajad Ahmad No. 896MRP/19 Bn. from point blank range and injured him. Taking advantage of huge crowd, the terrorists succeeded in

fleeing from the spot. On receipt of docket, FIR No.82/2011 for the commission of offences under sections 307, 7/27 of Arms Act was registered in Police Station, Hazratbal. During the spot visit one empty cartridge was recovered and seized, the seizure memo and the site plan were prepared. The statements of the eye witnesses were recorded under section 161 CrPC. As constable Sajad Ahmad No. 896 MRP/19 Bn., was drenched in blood, he was shifted to SKIMS, wherein he was admitted and kept under treatment. The injured constable, who was under treatment in SIKIMS Soura, during intervening night of October 14-15, 2011 succumbed to injuries. In this regard, Death Memo was prepared and dead-body was sent to Postmortem to Police Hospital Srinagar accompanied by PW-23. Subsequently, offence under section 302 of RPC was added in FIR and offence under section 307 of RPC was dropped. 1st Additional Sessions Judge Srinagar Ajay K Gupta after hearing both

the sides observed that witnesses examined by the prosecution, have not been able to put forth in their evidence in a ring of truth, so as to inspire confidence of the court to come to the firm conclusion that the alleged offence has been committed by the accused persons. Evidence of prosecution witnesses, is qualitatively and quantitatively, insufficient to bring nexus between accused persons and commission of the offences indicted against them. This renders the entire story of prosecution as incredible and unbelievable in the manner projected by the prosecution. "On proper assessment, evaluation and estimation of the evidence adduced by the prosecution, the evidence appears to be weak, fragile, lacking in credibility, does not prove connecting link

between the accused persons and commission of offences. It would be highly dangerous and hazardous to hold the accused persons guilty of offences alleged against them on the basis of weak, shaky and unacceptable evidence. The whole case of the prosecution, therefore, becomes doubtful. For the foregoing reasons and discussion made herein above in detail, prosecution has miserably failed to prove the guilt of accused Muzaffar Ahmad Mir beyond reasonable doubt for commission of offences. The prosecution has also miserably failed to prove the guilt of accused No.2 Showket Ahmed Bhat beyond reasonable doubt for commission of offences under sections 420/467/471 of RPC," the Court observed.
