

# Dr Jitendra holds 'bilateral' talks with German Minister, focuses on 'AI' Start-Ups

BERLIN: India and Germany have agreed to work together with focus on Artificial Intelligence (AI) Start-Ups as well as AI research and its application in Sustainability and Health care, said Dr Jitendra Singh, Minister for Science & Technology and Earth Sciences after he held "bilateral" talks with German Minister for Education & Research, Bettina Stark-Watzinger.

Both the Ministers agreed that there is a lot of scope to work together in Artificial Intelligence for which experts on two sides have already met. An Indo-German call for proposals for this would be raised soon inviting proposals from researchers and industry.

Dr Jitendra Singh recalled that in November 2019, during Chancellor Merkel's visit to Delhi, Germany and India had agreed to establish a joint research programme in Artificial Intelligence. They also decided on the extension of the Indo-German Partnership in Higher Education for another four years, with contributions of 3.5 Million Euros each.

Both India and Germany

have expressed satisfaction on the ongoing Science & Technology Cooperation between the two countries which is one of the strategic pillars of our bilateral relationship. Academia, Research Institutions and Industries of both countries have strong bonding and are playing the role of catalyst in our strategic research and development partnerships.

On the third day of his official engagement in Berlin, Dr Jitendra Singh mentioned that both the countries are now working in frontier areas of science & technology, including Electric Mobility, Cyber Physical System, Quantum

Technologies, Future Manufacturing, Green Hydrogen Fuel, Deep Ocean research and proposed to develop joint cooperation in these areas. Two countries have already started mapping each other's strength in areas like application of Artificial Intelligence in Sustainability and Healthcare.

Both the Ministers expressed satisfaction on recently concluded MOU between Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India and German Research Foundation (DFG) to support the International Research Training Groups (IRTG)

program would further boost the cooperation towards capacity building targeting the training of Indian and German students for pursuing the PhD program. The maiden call for inviting proposals under this program from Indian and German research groups is already on.

Both Ministers felt delighted that several initiatives for human capacity developments in science and engineering have recently been worked out, which includes Women Involvement in Science and Engineering Research (WISER) to facilitate lateral entry of women researchers into ongoing S&T projects and Paired Early Career Fellowships creating an inclusive ecosystem for the Indo-German S&T cooperation with exchange of young researchers on both sides.

Industrial Fellowships aimed at industrial exposure of young Indian researchers in a German industrial ecosystem.

Dr Jitendra Singh mentioned that the Government of India under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi gives great importance to innovation.

## JMC's Garbage Transfer Stations without compactors proving to be damp squib

Despite crores being spent on filth, garbage continue to lie on streets, roads

JAMMU: There is no doubt that Jammu Municipal Corporation (JMC) takes pain in bringing innovation in civic infrastructure and never hesitates in importing the latest technology to improve Temple City's civic conditions by remaining abreast with what is going on at the global level but when it comes to the implementation part things often go haywire as is the case of newly constructed garbage transfer stations, which are lying unused in absence of fixed compactors despite dissipation of crores of rupees for construction of such transfer stations.

It is pertinent to mention that Jammu Municipal Corporation has constructed garbage transfer stations in many wards to ensure proper disposal of solid waste and management of the garbage in a scientific manner but the sad part of the story is that the will to accomplish job in an exuberant manner is missing as these stations have lying unused for the last more than six to eight months due to which filths are lying here and there unattended in the streets and stray cattle finding it easy to gulp tons of polythene which is still a big part of the city's garbage despite being banned years ago.

Talking to STATE TIMES, Councillor Mohi-Ud-Din Choudhary expressed resentment against the functioning of the Jammu Municipal Corporation. He said that compactors could be reached Jammu before constructing of such transfers stations. Due to mismanagement, the sufferings of people have

been increased manifold. Mohi-Ud-Din Choudhary said that instead of managing the garbage the JMC has recently closed the dumping point near Pir Kho Temple at Cireular Road as the same dumping point caters to nearly four wards comprising No 3, 5, 6 and 7. He said that after the closure of this garbage collecting point, Garbage collecting autos are straightaway going to the Bhagwati Nagar to dump the garbage collected from the residential areas which seems to be a great inconvenience for the sanitation workers in collecting the waste and shifting the same to Bhagwati Nagar Corporator Ward No 32, Sat Paul Karlipur, said that it's the responsibility of JMC authorities to install compactors well before time but it could not happen. He said the whole Jammu city is waiting for installation of compactors. He made a fervent appeal to the JMC Commissioner to immediately carry out necessary steps to make these garbage shifting stations functional so that the garbage should be managed scientifically instead of remaining scattered on the roads.

Mayor Chander Mohan Gupta told STATE TIMES that the Municipal Corporations has placed an order for fixed compactors in several wards of Jammu city and very soon the same will be installed at the garbage transfer stations thus paving way for the start of the modern technique of garbage disposal. He hoped that such garbage transfer stations should be made functional within a period of one month with the installation of fixed compactors.
