





CRIME REPORT

Two missing girls traced, reunited with families

REASI: Police on Wednesday traced two missing girls and reunited them with their families.

As per the details, On May 2, 2022 a written complaint was lodged by a man resident of Chassana that his daughter (name withheld) age 19 years Who went to market for Shopping and did not return back, he searched here & there but no clue found. On getting this information a Missing report entered at Police Station Chassana.

During the course of investigation team started searching the girl. Enquiry was made from family members, neighbors etc. finally after hectic efforts girl got traced from Budhal area of Rajouri within 24 hours and handed over to her legal heirs after completing legal formalities.

In another incident a written complaint was lodged by person resident of Mahore that his daughter (name withheld) got missed from Shajroo. On this information a Missing report entered in Police Post Shajroo and enquiry initiated. During enquiry after hectic efforts missing girl got traced from Janipur area of Jammu. After completing legal formalities, girl handed over to legal heirs.

Vijaypur MC seizes loads of goods during anti-encroachment drive

SAMBAL: Loads of goods and articles were seized on Wednesday by Vijaypur Municipal Committee(MC) during an anti-encroachment drive conducted along Jammu- Pathankot National Highway (NH) and Market area of Vijaypur town.

The drive was conducted by the Municipality Vijaypur in association with JK Police after receiving complaints from various quarters about encroachment on Highway, service lanes and minor roads. The anti encroachment team was led by Executive Officer Ravi Saini and SHO Rajeev Kumar.

The team seized all the goods including tools kept by the shopkeepers on the lanes and removed rebaries and make-shift shops from the service lanes. In total, around a truck-load of goods were seized by the team during its drive.

Meanwhile, the administration has appealed to shopkeepers and hawkers to adhere to the instructions and sell the vegetables, fruits and goods in the Rehbari zone only.

14 gamblers arrests; stake money seized

SRINAGAR: Acting tough against social crimes, Police on Wednesday arrested 14 gamblers from Srinagar & Sopore districts and seized stake money from their possession.





Woman arrested with heroin

KATHUA; District Police Kathua on Wednesday arrested a woman near Chak Drab Khan and recovered approx. 06-07 grams of heroin which narcotics from her possession.

As per the details, on the overall directions of SSP Kathua, R.C Kotwal, a police team of Police Station Kathua led by Insp. O P Chib SHO Kathua under the supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua Shammik Kumar during patrolling duty near Chak Drab Khan Kathua noticed the movement of one suspicious lady who was enroute from village Chak Drab Khan Kathua by foot who was directed to stop for checking.

On physical search, approximately 06-07 grams of heroin(Chitta) like narcotics was recovered from the illegal possession of one woman namely Ravinder Kumari, wife of Laxman Dass, resident of Chak Drab Khan, District Kathua. She was arrested and FIR No. 174/2022 under sections 8/21/22/NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Kathua.

Absconder arrested after 5 years

RAMBAN: Police on Wednesday arrested an absconder who was evading his arrest for the last five years.

As per the details, one absconder namely Mohd Danish Malik (alias Ishfaq Ahmed), son of Osman Ulah, resident of Tetharka Tehsil Gool Distt Ramban who was involved in case FIR No. 135/2017 under sections 382/323/504/506/201 RPC Police Station Ramban and was evading his arrest from the last five years, has been arrested and is presently in police custody and will be produced before Court of Law for judicial determination.

The arrest was effected by police team headed by Insp Sandeep Charak SHO Ramban under the supervision of Pardeep Singh Sen DySP Hqrs Ramban with the overall supervision of Mohita Sharma, SP Ramban.

When an X-ray machine checked his luggage at booth number-5 at the drop gate of the airport, it was found that there were cartridges in one of his bags.

The security personnel took him into custody simultaneously and opened his bag. The bag contained a live cartridge of an INSAS rifle. The tourist from whose bag the cartridge was found has been identified as Shailesh Kumar Pandya, resident of Navagam-2 Panchmahal, Gujarat.

He had reached Srinagar on 26 April on IndiGo flight number 6E-6351 from Mumbai to visit Kashmir along with eight others.

During interrogation, he said that when he visited Gulmarg, he had picked up a cartridge of INSAS rifle lying in an unclaimed condition on the ground at one place



there. Therefore, a case is being registered against him at Humhama Police Station, and further investigation is being done.
