80 vaccinated, 1297 samples collected in Ramban

RAMBAN: As per District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr Suresh, the Health Department on Wednesday administered covid vaccination doses to 80 persons including 40 children in the 12-14 age-Group. Continuing the enforcement drive to implement Covid protocol, the Enforcement teams fined scores of violators for

roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance.

The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs. 600 from violators. The Medical Officer, Dr.

Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking Covid vaccination doses at their nearest CVC. As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Dr.

Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department collected 1297 samples including 371 RT-PCR and 926 RAT and administered Covid vaccine doses to 80 persons at various dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.
