1. That a series of writ petitions were filed before the Hon'ble High Court, in Connection with fixation of Seniority of AWW's and promotion of AWWs to teh Post of Supervisors. In these writ petitions some of the petitioners have challenged the government order No. 76-SW of 2019 dated:- 28-02-2019 in terms of which the seniority of Anganwari Workers, who have acquired higher qualification (Graduation) during service shall be taken from the date of Acquiring the higher qualification instead of the date of their initial appointment. 2. That the hon'ble court was pleased to club the writ petitions and was pleased to pass a judgement dated:- 14-02-2023 in SWP No. 667/2018, titled Ms. Syeda Nazir V/S State of J&K and Another and Clubbed Matter s, the operative part of which is as under:- "Viewed what has been observed, Considered and analyzed hereinabove, the impugned Clause-1 incorporated in Government Order No. 76-SW of 2019 dated 28-02-2019 issued by respondent 1 is quashed, as a consequence whereof the respondents are commandment to fix the seniority of Anganwari workers on the basis of their initial engagement as anganwari workers in tune with rules of 1991 read with rule 24 of the J&K CCA Rules." 3. The caveator's Apprehends that the Non-Caveator's will challenge the Judgement dated:- 14-02-2023, Passed by the hon'ble high court in SWP No. 667/2018, Titled Syeda Nazir V/S State of J&K & Another and Clubbed Matters. The caveator's will suffer in running the smooth functioning of department. It is further submitted that the caveator's will not be able to conduct the Department Promotion Committees for Selection/ appointment of Anganwadi Workers as supervisors. The Caveator's will also be affected in case the caveator's will not be afforded an opportunity of being heard before passing any interim relief/ direction. The Caveator's have a right of Hearing.
