

## SKUAST-J organizes training of farmers for better mango production

JAMMU: One day training programme on the "management of flowering for better production in mango" was organized by SKUAST-Jammu under the NABARD funded research project entitled "Transfer of technology for management of alternate bearing problem through hormonal intervention in mango varieties of Jammu region".

The training was organized in the orchards of Rajendrapura, Samba where the farmers from the villages of Baguna, Simbal Bali, Bari and Raya were participated.

Dr Bhav Kumar Sinha, Associate Professor (Physiology) and Principal Investigator of the project, delivered a talk on the earning of mango fruits from abiotic stress conditions whereas Dr. Reena, Professor (Entomology) and Co-PI of the project, informed the farmers about bio intensive integrated management for mango insect / pests.

Dr. Rakesh Kumar, Associate Professor (Pomology) educated the farmers about overall management of mango orchards and Shailesh Sharma, DDM, NABARD, Samba discussed about

various programmes launched by NABARD for the upliftment of the farmer status. During the training, fruit fly traps / lures were distributed to the selected farmers and hands-on training for preparation of pheromone traps to manage fruit flies, mango hoppers, mealy bugs, was also imparted to the farmers

The proceedings of the training were conducted by Dr. Sonika Jamwal Associate Professor (Pathology) and formal vote of thanks were presented by Dr. Vikas Sharma Associate Prof (Biochemistry).

JAMMU: Justice Tashi Rabstan, Judge, High Court of J&K and Ladakh and also Chairperson, Juvenile Justice Committee, accompanied by Sunit Gupta, Principal District and Sessions Judge, Bhaderwah, Amit Kumar Gupta, Member Secretary, J&K Legal Services Authority and Kameshwar Puri, Additional SP, Bhaderwah on Sunday visited District Jail, Bhaderwah to take stock of facilities being provided to the Jail inmates.

On his arrival Justice Tashi was received by Superintendent, District Jail, Bhaderwah where after he visited all the barracks in the jail and found the same over crowded. On enquiry the Superintendent, informed the Justice Tashi that the said jail has a capacity of about 150 persons whereas, at present 187 inmates were lodged that include under trials, convicted prisoners and the persons detained under PSA. He further informed that many inmates were shifted to Bhaderwah jail from different Districts of UT of J&K. It was also

brought to the notice of Justice Tashi that no permanent doctor has been posted in the jail despite a sanctioned post whereas a doctor has been deputed to visit jail on weekly basis.

During an interaction with the jail inmates some under-trial prisoners informed Justice Tashi that at the time of recording of statement of witnesses when they appear virtually in the case, they are not able to hear the statement of witness being recorded, upon which Justice Tashi issued on the spot directions to the Superintendent jail and Principal District Judge, Bhaderwah to ensure glitch free connectivity of the jail with the courts. Another issue, raised by the inmates, was with regard to the higher call rates of STD facility provided in the jail.

Justice Tashi appreciated and was more than satisfied on coming to know from the jail inmates that each one of them was being represented either by a Private Counsel or Panel/Legal Aid Defence Counsel in their respective cases. Subsequently, Justice Tashi also inspected the Computer Centre, Ration

Store, Kitchen where the food for the jail inmates is prepared. He also had a virtual interaction with the Additional District Judge, Doda from the VC facility room in the jail itself.

Later, Justice Tashi visited District Jail, Kishtwar where he was received by Superintendent jail who informed the Judge that the jail has a capacity of 68 persons, whereas almost 100 inmates were accommodated in the said jail. The Superintendent also raised a concern about the acute shortage of manpower due to which the staff posted in the said jail is required to work beyond the specified time. It was also brought to the notice of Justice Tashi that the Medical Officer posted earlier in the said jail has been transferred without posting a substitute, so, the doctor deputed, visits the jail on weekly basis or is available on call.

Justice Tashi, accompanied by Manjeet Manhas, Principal District and Sessions Judge, Kishtwar, Amit Kumar Gupta, Member Secretary, J&K Legal Services Authority, Dr.Devansh Yadav, Deputy Commissioner, Mahmud Anwar Alnasir, Chief Judicial Magistrate/

Principal Magistrate JJB, Rajinder Singh, Additional SP and Mansoor Ahmed, APP also visited Home for Children (Boys) namely "Palash", "Place of Safety" at Hidayal (Kishtwar) and "Aashiana" a SOS Home run by a private NGO and reviewed the functioning of the said Homes and impressed upon the officers/officials of the Social Welfare Department to take personal initiative for the welfare of the children and not consider this as a 10 to 4 duty. He also urged them to take the cause of children as a mission because a noble work requires full dedication, initiative and zeal.

Justice Tashi impressed upon the DCPD and the warden to improve the diet of the inmates as they need balanced and nutritious diet. He further directed the said officers to promote information technology and its learning amongst the children to ensure that they remain abreast with the fast-moving society in this digital age.

Thereafter, Justice Tashi instructed the authorities to promote sports and other co-curricular activities amongst these children besides promoting study culture and public speaking so that the children residing in the home

can express themselves in a loud way. Justice Tashilauded the efforts of 'Aashian' shelter home and appreciated their efforts in bringing up children acquainting them with all the modern techniques.

Justice Tashi also visited "Place of Safety" created in terms of the Juvenile Justice Care & Protection of Children, Act where heinteracted with two juveniles in conflict with law, out of whom, one was involved in offence u/s 302IPC while the other was facing inquiry for offences u/s 363, 376IPC. Justice Tashi raised the concern of creating the "Place of Safety" in a building also housing the police post and directed the Member Secretary, JJC, to convene a meeting with the Secretary to Government, Social Welfare Department, UT of J&K and Mission Director, Mission Vatsalya at an earliest possible as the "Place of Safety" created was dehors the basic spirit of the Act.

On this occasion, Justice Tashi was appraised by the Principal Magistrate JJB, Kishtwar that two meetings of all the stake holders in Mission Vatsalya and authorities connected to Juvenile Justice Board and its ancillary organizations have been held in the past, wherein this issue was brought to the notice of the concerned authorities, however, no response for housing such Juveniles has been received so far despite a lapse of almost five months. It was also brought to the notice of Justice Tashi that the building, presently housing Juvenile Justice Board, Kishtwar is a private building which is neither conducive nor suitable and is required to be shifted to a better place.

## Navies of India, Indonesia begin 6-day exercise

NEW DELHI: The navies of India and Indonesia on Sunday began a six-day maritime exercise in sync with their overall efforts to expand bilateral military engagement.

The Indian Navy has deployed its indigenously built anti-submarine warfare corvette INS Kavaratti, a Dornier maritime patrol aircraft and a Chetak chopper for the Samudra Shakti exercise, officials said.

Earlier, the Navy said the

ship arrived at Batam Port in Indonesia for the exercise.

The Indonesian Navy is being represented at the exercise by warship KRI Sultan Iskandar Muda, CN 235 maritime patrol aircraft and AS565 panther helicopter, they said.


"Exercise Samudra Shakti is aimed at enhancing interoperability, jointness and mutual cooperation between both the navies," the Indian Navy said.

It said the harbour phase of the exercise will comprise

cross-deck visits, professional interactions and subject matter expert exchanges.

"During the sea phase, weapon firing, helicopter operations, anti-submarine warfare and air defence exercises and boarding operations are planned," the Navy said in a release.

"Samudra Shakti will showcase the high level of interoperability between the two navies and their shared commitment towards peace and stability in the region," it added.
