Inqlabi demands retaining of lab at DH Rajouri

JAMMU: In an open letter to the LG Manoj Sinha , Ch. Rashid Azam Inqlabi has taken up the issue of shifting of laboratory from Associate Hospital Kehora, Rajouri to

under construction building of medical college at village Mehra Nagrota.

Inqlabi, in a letter, said that the under construction building at Mehra Nagrota is about seven kilometers away from Associate Hospital Kehora, Rajouri and patients will have to face a lot of difficulties in getting the different type of tests prescribed by the doctors of Associate Hospital. The patients belonging to rural areas and poor families are being severely affected due to this act of the Hospital authorities, he said adding that the condition of people residing in Poonch and Rajouri districts is quite different from people residing in other areas as they are not in position to get all the

tests conducted privately from open market.

The letter further reads, the people of Rajouri and poonch are facing border disturbances and proxy war for the last three decades. There is great necessity for strengthening of District Hospital and providing good infrastructure to the hospital. Despite considerable lapse of time, No private health sector has flourished till now in Rajouri and Poonch. Ch. Inqlabi has demanded that the LG shall direct the Health secretary to intervene in this matter and direct the authorities not to shift the laboratory from Associate Hospital Rajouri in the interest of public at large and patients in particular.
