

The matter escalated so much that the SPO was assaulted after she was taken to the local hospital from where she was referred to GMC. The woman was complaining of shortness of breath. On receiving information, police officers also went to the hospital and took her statement in which she said that Munshi strangulated her and also accused a police officer too. While in his statement Munshi said he didn't assaulted the woman SPO. He said that she had come to the police station and without any reason started arguing with him. Later she left the police station and fell down outside. Different statements are coming out from both the sides due to which the matter has become complicated. It is pertinent to mention here woman SPO's husband had died few years back in the custody of the police station.

#### Three-storey house gutted

RAJOURI: A tree-storey house comprising seven rooms was gutted while a buffalo was also charred alive in a fire incident in the remote Gabbar village of Rajouri district. Police officials said that no loss of human life has taken place in this fire incident but a buffalo domesticated by the family was charred alive. People of the area have demanded from the administration that it should provide financial aid to the victim's family and help in their rehabilitation.
