CRIME REPORT

2 drug peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

BARAMULLA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police on Thursday arrested 2 drug peddlers in Baramulla and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

As per details, a party led by Police Station Pattan during Naka checking near NHIW Zangam Pattan intercepted a vehicle bearing registration number DL4CAP-5100 driven by one person. During checking, officers were able to recover 310 Spasmo Proxyvon Plus tablets from his possession. He has been identified as Waheed Sultan Ganie alias Raaj Don son of Mohd Sultan Ganie resident of Shirpora Pattan.

Similarly, a party of Police Post Delina at a checkpoint established at Delina Baramulla intercepted a vehicle (Scorpio) bearing registration number JK05B-1660 driven by one person identified as Rouf Ahmad Mir son of Ghulam Hassan Mir resident of Model Town Sopore. During checking, officers were able to recover 165 grams of Charas like substance from his possession.

Both the accused persons have been arrested and shifted to respective police stations where they remain in custody. Vehicles used in the commission of crime have also been seized.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective police stations and further investigation have been initiated.

2 vehicles seized, 2 arrested for illegal extraction of minerals

BARAMULLA: Acting tough against the persons involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, police have seized 2 vehicles and arrested 2 persons in Baramulla.

As per details, a police party led by SHO Police Station Tangmarg seized 2 vehicles (1 Excavator & 1 Tipper) and arrested 2 persons identified as Mohd Rafiq Zargar son of Shamim Ahmad resident of Druroo & Danish Ahmad Malik son of Bashir Ahmad Malik resident of Paraswani, involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals at Ferozpora Nallah Shurai Tangmarg.

Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Tangmarg and further investigation has been initiated.

Police files chargesheet in Soibug rape & murder case

SRINAGAR: Police in Budgam presented challan in brutal rape and murder case of a lady in Soibug, in the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate Budgam.

The case pertains to the missing report lodged in Police Post Soibug of a lady on 8th of March 2023 and later on it was discovered during search that she had been murdered & her body dismembered. During investigation, police arrested the accused person Shabir Ahmad Wani of Mohanpora Budgam for his involvement in the commission of crime and a case FIR No 53/23 under section 302 IPC was lodged in Police Station Budgam. It was further revealed that the victim had been raped before being murdered and dismembered. This led to the addition of the rape charge under section 376 of the IPC.

The accused Shabir Ahmad Wani is currently in judicial custody. The charge sheet containing charges under Sections 302, 376 and 201 of the IPC has been produced in the court of Hon'ble Chief Judicial Magistrate Budgam.

Youth tries to kidnapped girl, FIR registered

SAMBA: Some youths tried to kidnap a girl in Samba however they failed to do so. Police has registered a case and started investigation.

Sources said that, the incident took place on Friday afternoon at around 3.30 pm, when a 17-year-old girl from the hilly area of Samba was walking towards the new Bus Stand, Samba on reaching near the district hospital, Samba, suddenly a youth namely Ashwani Singh, son of Ludan Singh, resident of Bedi (Samba) slapped the girl and forced her to sit in the vehicle (JK02-0017) being driven by an unknown driver. When the girl raised an alarm, some locals reached the spot, over this accused threw the girl out of the car and fled from the spot. The matter was reported to Samba Police and on the statement of the girl, police has registered a case against the accused under FIR No. 129/23 under sections 341/323/382/354/363 /511 IPC and 7 POCSO Act.

It is pertinent to mention here woman SPO's husband had died few years back in the custody of the police station.

1.5 lakh rupees withdrawn from bank account fraudulently

Three-storey house gutted

Police officials said that no loss of human life has taken place in this fire incident but a buffalo domesticated by the family was charred alive. People of the area have demanded from the administration that it should provide financial aid to the victim's family and help in their rehabilitation.
